WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1927

Ottawa, February, 1929.- A report on the Women's Factory Clothing industry in Canada during the calendar year 1927 is presented herewith.

The industry comprises women's clothing, ladies and children's wear, women's neckwear and fancy goods, embroidery and trimmings, laces, tapes and bindings. Reports were received from 426 establishments which was an increase of 41 over the number reported for 1926. The following summary table gives the number of establishments by classes with their location by provinces.

WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1927

Production

The selling value of the principal products of the industry is given by provinces in Table 2 for the calendar year 1927. The total value of production rose from \$50,658,319 in 1926 to \$56,316,064 in 1927, a net increase of \$5,657,745 over the two year period. By provinces Ontario leads with a gross value of all products of \$30,107,031 followed by Quebec, with \$23,327,233. Manitoba takes third place with \$2,047,636, whilst in fourth position British Columbia accounted for \$600,545, the remaining \$233,619 being contributed by the Maritime and other Prairie provinces.

Size of Establishments

In view of the tendency toward concentration in industrial enterprise a series of tables has been prepared presenting in a threefold way the size of the establishments in the women's factory clothing industry measured by (a) capital investment (b) gross value of production and (c) the number of persons employed, all within certain specified groups or limitations for the calendar years 1926 and 1927. The tables further serve to indicate the movement of capital, production and employment within the industry.

In 1926 the number of establishments reporting was 385 with a total capital investment of \$21,972,236 a gross value of production of \$50,658,319 and a total employment of 13,987. In capital investment four establishments had a capital investment of \$4,511,224 or 20.5 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$1,127,806. In gross value of production fourteen establishments had a total of \$17,251,954 or 34 per cent of their total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,232,282. In employment four establishments had a combined payroll of 3,752, or 26.8 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 938.

In 1927 the number of establishments reporting was 428 with a total capital investment of \$24,259,925 a gross value of production of \$56,316,064 and a total employment of 15,597. In capital investment five establishments had a capital investment of \$4,951,654 or 20.4 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$990,331. In gross value of production fourteen establishments had a total of \$17,524,423 or 31 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,251,744. In employment five establishments had a combined payroll of 3,924 or 25.2 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 784.8.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital employed in the industry during 1927 is shown by kinds and provinces in Table 3. Fixed capital which includes, land, buildings, machinery and tools fell from \$5,532,892 in 1926 to \$5,347,411 in 1927, a decrease of \$185,481 or 3.4 per cent. Working capital which includes materials, supplies and stocks on hand together with cash, trading and operating accounts, etc. increased during that period from \$16,439,344 to \$18,912,514, an increase of \$2,473,170 or 15.0 per cent. Percentages of the total capital investment by provinces according to rank were as follows:- Ontario 56.6; Quebec 39.2; Manitoba 2.7; British Columbia 0.9 and the Maritime and Other Prairie provinces 0.6.

Employment Statistics

Statistics relating to employment will be found in Tables 4, 5 and 6. Table 4 shows the number of persons employed by classes, sex and remuneration as well as by provinces. Compared with 1926 there were increases in employment of 147 in the salaried class of 1,463 in the wage earning class, and 61 in the number of outside piece workers. Salaries increased by \$240,624 wages paid by \$1,327,887 and the amount paid to outside piece workers by \$7,358. The average salary per employee irrespective of sex was approximately \$1,953 in 1926 whilst in 1927 it had fallen to \$1,926 or a decrease of a little over 1.3 per cent. The average wage of all employees rose from about \$878 in 1926 to \$883 in 1927, or a percentage increase of 0.6.

Other Employment Statistics

The number and percentage of wage-earners in months of highest employment working specified hours per day is shown in Table 6(a) for Canada and the provinces. For the Dominion, the number working specified hours was distributed between the classes, the percentage working 8 hours being highest. British Columbia has the highest percentage of employees working 8 hours per diem, whilst in Manitoba, Ontario and the other Prairie provinces the 8 hour day prevails. In Quebec over 69 p.c. of the wage-earners work 9 hours. In the provinces of Quebec and Ontario only are workers employed for periods exceeding 9 hours a day.

The number of hours worked per day in the month of highest employment and the standard working hours per week are shown by provinces in Table 6(b). It should be noted that whilst the statistics relating to hours of labour in columns 1, 2 and 3 are based on figures compiled for the month of highest employment, those in column 4 and 5 represent the total and average of standard weekly hours of labour for the number of establishments reporting to the Bureau. For this reason the relation between daily and weekly hours of labour is to some extent impaired. The average daily hours of labour on the above basis was for the Dominion 8.4 whilst the average standard weekly hours worked out at 46.0 per plant.



Power Installation

The power employed in this industry was almost wholly electric, and was all purchased. There were 2 steam engines with a capacity of 58 horse power, and the number of electric motors reported totalled 1,049 with a rated horsepower of 2,939. Boilers installed for any purpose were 17 in number with a horsepower capacity of 482.

Imports and Exports

Imports and Exports of Women's factory or "ready to wear" clothing are not distinctively specified in the trade returns but are included in the items designated as clothing of cotton, linen, silk and wool, n.o.p., as summarized in Table 9 for the calendar year, 1927.

The total value of such imports amounted during this period to \$11,654,972 of which \$5,253,819 came from the United Kingdom \$2,587,335 from the United States and \$3,813,818 from other countries.




