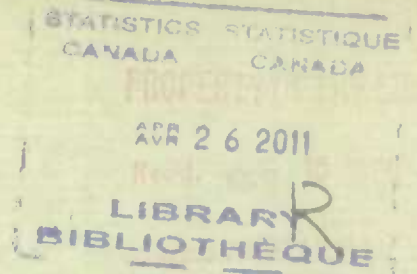

WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928

Ottawa, January 1930.— A report on the Women's Factory Clothing industry in Canada during the calendar year 1928 is presented herewith. The industry comprises women's clothing, ladies and children's wear, women's neckwear and fancy goods, embroidery and trimmings, laces, tapes and bindings. Reports were received from 444 establishments which was an increase of 18 over the number reported for 1927. The following summary table gives the number of establishments by classes with their location by provinces.

WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928

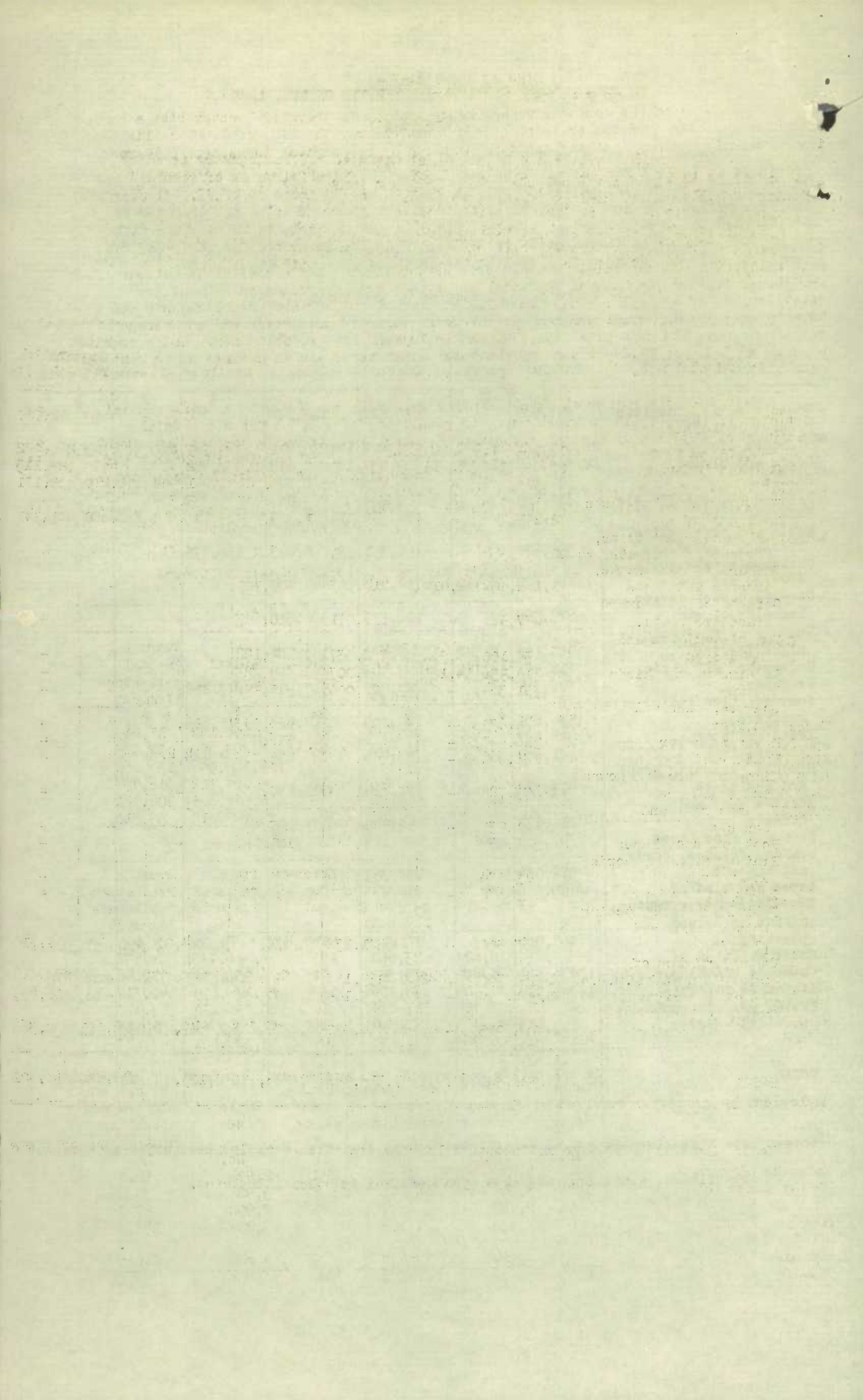
Production

The selling value of the principal products of the industry is given by provinces in Table 2 for the calendar year 1928. The total value of production rose from \$56,316,064 in 1927 to \$63,326,501 in 1928, a net increase of \$7,010,437 over the two year period. By provinces Ontario leads with a gross value of all products of \$32,806,828 followed by Quebec, with \$27,314,966. Manitoba takes third place with \$2,105,858, whilst in fourth position, British Columbia accounted for \$815,422, the remaining \$223,427 being contributed by the Maritime provinces and Alberta.

Size of Establishments

In view of the tendency toward concentration in industrial enterprise a series of tables has been prepared presenting in a threefold way the size of the establishments in the women's factory clothing industry measured by (a) capital investment (b) gross value of production and (c) the number of persons employed, all within certain specified groups or limitations for the calendar years 1927 and 1928. The tables further serve to indicate the movement of capital, production and employment within the industry.

In 1927 the number of establishments reporting was 428 with a total capital investment of \$24,259,925, a gross value of production of \$56,316,064 and a total employment of 15,597. In capital investment five establishments had a capital investment of \$4,951,654 or 20.4 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$990,331. In gross value of production fourteen establishments had a total of \$17,524,423 or 31 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,251,744. In employment five establishments had a combined payroll of 3,924 or 25.2 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 784.8.

In 1928 the number of establishments reporting was 444 with a total capital investment of \$25,557,610, a gross value of production of \$63,326,501 and a total employment of 16,351. In capital investment 5 establishments had a capital investment of \$4,544,605 or 17.78 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$908,921. In gross value of production 19 establishments had a total of \$21,430,346 or 33.84 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,127,913. In employment 6 establishments had a combined payroll of 3,845 or 23.51 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 641.0.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital employed in the industry during 1928 is shown by kinds and provinces in Table 3. Fixed capital which includes land, buildings, machinery and tools rose from \$5,347,411 in 1927 to \$5,498,728 in 1928, an increase of \$151,317 or 2.8 per cent. Working capital which includes materials, supplies and stocks on hand together with cash, trading and operating accounts, etc. increased during that period from \$18,912,514 to \$20,058,882, an increase of \$1,146,368 or 6.06 per cent. Percentages of the total capital investment by provinces according to rank were as follows:- Ontario 54.1, Quebec 41.4, Manitoba 2.9, British Columbia 1.1 and the Maritime Provinces and Alberta 0.5.

Employment Statistics

Statistics relating to employment will be found in Tables 4, 5 and 6. Table 4 shows the number of persons employed by classes, sex and remuneration as well as by provinces. Compared with 1927 there were increases in employment of 128 in the salaried class, of 626 in the wage earning class and a decrease of 4 in the number of outside piece workers. Salaries increased by \$346,218, wages paid by \$989,180 but the amount paid to outside piece workers decreased by \$2,726. The average salary per employee irrespective of sex was approximately \$1,926 in 1927 whilst in 1928 it rose to \$1,989 or an increase of a little over 3.2 per cent. The average wage of all employees rose from \$883 in 1927 to \$899 in 1928 or a percentage increase of 1.8.

Table 5 presents statistics of the operating time of plants and of employees. The operating time of plants is shown according to (a) full time, (b) part time, and (c) idle, whilst for employees the total and average hours normally worked per day and per week are shown.

In Table 6 the number of employees on the payroll for each month of the year is shown according to sex. Employment reached the maximum in October with a total of 15,331. It was lowest in the month of December when the total employment stood at 12,859. The average enrolment for the year was 3,961 males and 10,559 females, a total of 14,520.

Other Employment Statistics

The number and percentage of wage-earners in months of highest employment working specified hours per day is shown in Table 6(a) for Canada and the provinces. For the Dominion, the number working specified hours was distributed between the classes, the percentage working 8 hours being highest. British Columbia has the highest percentage of employees working 8 hours per diem, whilst in Manitoba, Ontario and Alberta the 8 hour day prevails. In Quebec over 58 p.c. of the wage-earners work 9 hours. In the provinces of Quebec, Ontario and Manitoba are workers employed for periods exceeding 9 hours a day.

Other Employment Statistics (Cont'd.)

The number of hours worked per day in the month of highest employment and the standard working hours per week are shown by provinces in Table 6(b). It should be noted that whilst the statistics relating to hours of labour in columns 1, 2 and 3 are based on figures compiled for the month of highest employment, those in column 4 and 5 represent the total and average of standard weekly hours of labour for the number of establishments reporting to the Bureau. For this reason the relation between daily and weekly hours of labour is to some extent impaired. The average daily hours of labour on the above basis was for the Dominion 8.3 whilst the average standard weekly hours worked out at 45.8 per plant.

Fuel Consumption

The quantity and cost value of the fuel consumed in the industry during 1928 is shown in Table 7. The cost of electricity purchased during the year was \$155,764 as compared with \$160,598 in 1927.

Power Installation

The power employed in this industry was wholly electric, and was all purchased, and the number of electric motors reported totalled 1,067 with a rated horsepower of 2,875. Boilers installed for any purpose were 30 in number with a horsepower capacity of 430.

Imports and Exports

Imports and Exports of Women's factory or "ready to wear" clothing are not distinctively specified in the trade returns but are included in the items designated as clothing of cotton, linen, silk and wool, n.o.p., as summarized in Table 9 for the calendar year, 1928.

The total value of such imports amounted during this period to \$12,143,904 of which \$4,791,223 came from the United Kingdom, \$3,736,258 from the United States and \$3,616,423 from other countries.

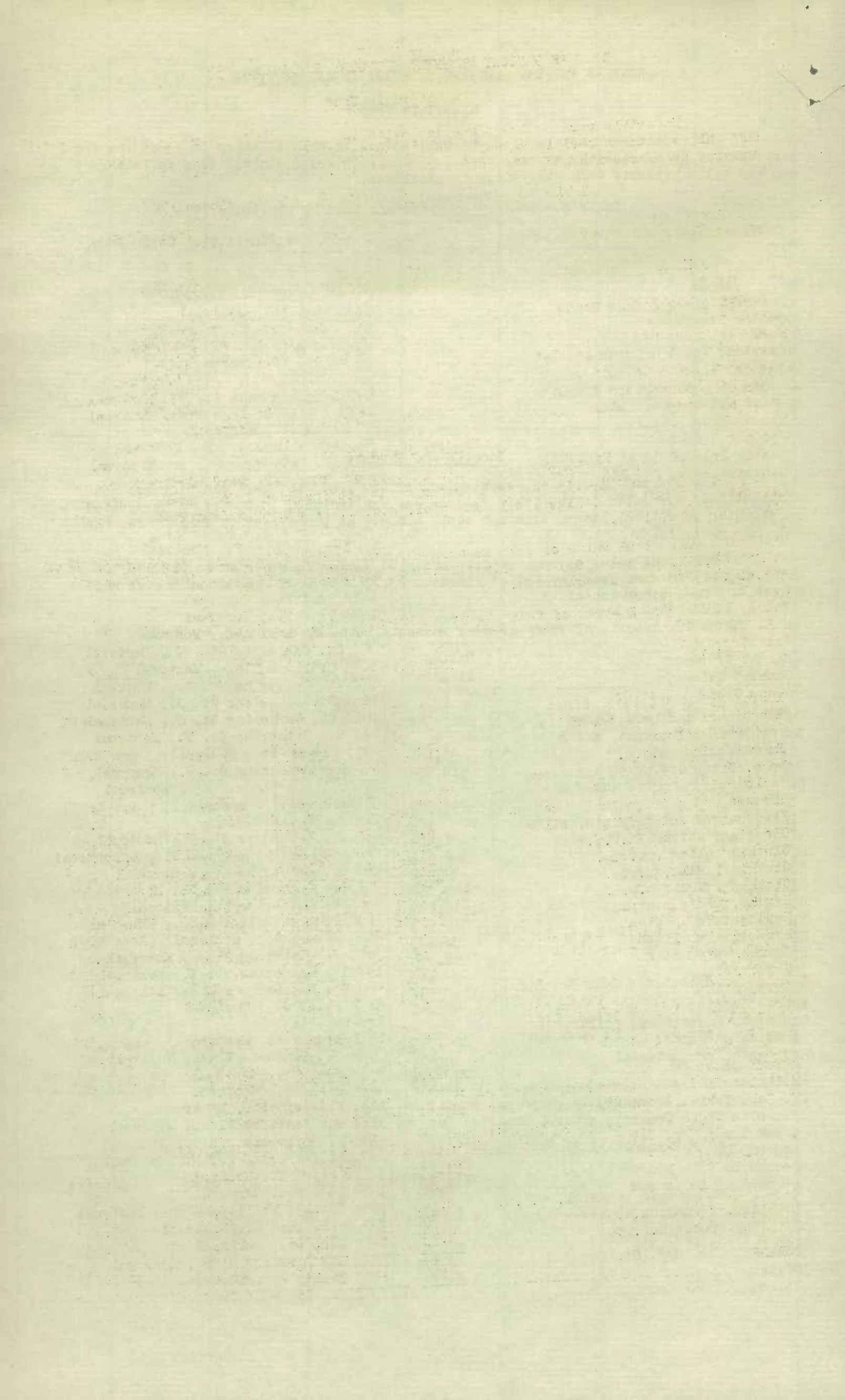

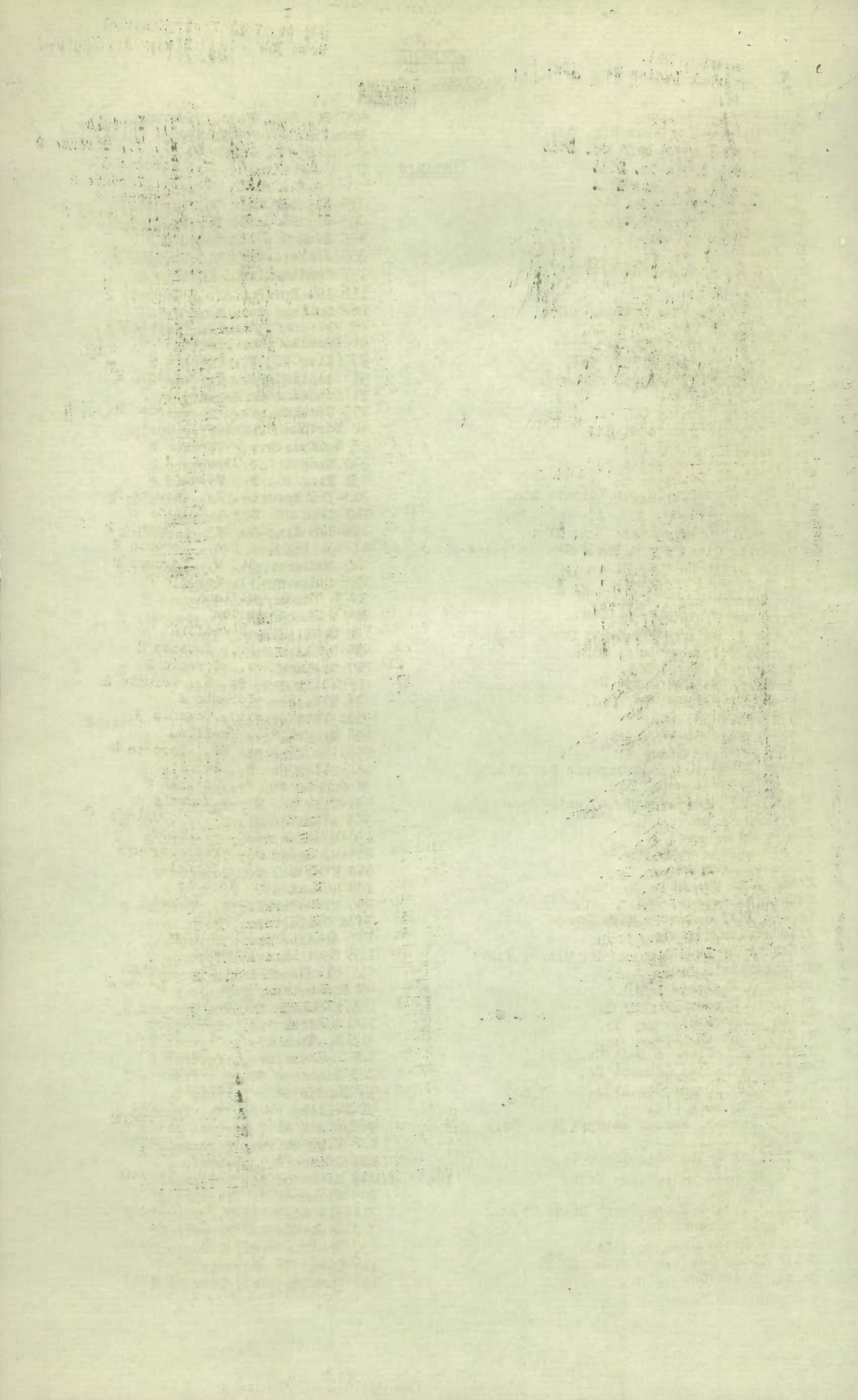
