

WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1929.

Ottawa, February, 1931. - A report on the Women's Factory Clothing industry in Canada during the calendar year 1929 is presented herewith. The industry comprises women's clothing, ladies and children's wear, women's neckwear and fancy goods, embroidery and trimmings, laces, tapes and bindings. Reports were received from 461 establishments which was an increase of 17 over the number reported for 1928. The following summary table gives the number of establishments by classes with their location by provinces.



WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1929.


Production

The selling value of the principal products of the industry is given by provinces in Table 2 for the calendar year 1929. The total value of production rose from \$63,326,501 in 1928 to \$66,346,417 in 1929, a net increase of \$3,019,916 over the two year period. By provinces Ontario leads with a gross value of all products of \$32,499,548 followed by Quebec, with \$30,607,476. Manitoba takes third place with \$2,141,183, whilst in fourth position, British Columbia accounted for \$707,763, the remaining \$390,347 being contributed by the Maritime and Western provinces.

Size of Establishments


In view of the tendency toward concentration in industrial enterprise a series of tables has been prepared presenting in a threefold way the size of the establishments in the women's factory clothing industry measured by (a) capital investment, (b) gross value of production and (c) the number of persons employed, all within certain specified groups or limitations for the calendar years 1928 and 1929. The tables further serve to indicate the movement of capital, production and employment within the industry.

In 1928 the number of establishments reporting was 444 with a total capital investment of \$25,557,610, a gross value of production of \$63,326,501 and a total employment of 16,351. In capital investment 5 establishments had a capital investment of \$4,544,605 or 17.78 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$908,921. In gross value of production 19 establishments had a total of \$21,430,346 or 33.84 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,127.913. In employment 6 establishments had a combined payroll of 3,845 or 23.51 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 641.0.

In 1929 the number of establishments reporting was 461 with a total capital investment of \$25,087,862, a gross value of production of \$66,346,417 and a total employment of 17,024. In capital investment 5 establishments had a capital investment of \$3,965,260 or 15.8 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$793,052. In gross value of production 19 establishments had a total of \$21,216,006 or 31.9 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,116,632. In employment 6 establishments had a combined payroll of 3,739 or 21.9 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 623.2.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital employed in the industry during 1929 is shown by kinds and provinces in Table 3. Fixed capital which includes land, buildings, machinery and tools fell from \$5,498,728 in 1928 to \$4,887,978 in 1929, a decrease of \$610,750 or 11.2 per cent. Working capital which includes materials, supplies and stocks on hand, together with cash, trading and operating accounts, etc., increased during that period from \$20,058,882 to \$20,199,884, an increase of \$141,002 or 0.7 per cent. Percentages of the total capital investment by provinces according to rank were as follows:- Ontario, 52.2; Quebec, 43.0; Manitoba, 3.1; British Columbia, 0.9 and the Maritime and Western provinces 0.8.


Statistics relating to employment will be found in Tables 4, 5 and 6. Table 4 shows the number of persons employed by classes, sex and remuneration as well as by provinces. Compared with 1928 there were increases in employment of 124 in the salaried class, of 549 in the wage earning class and of 270 in the number of outside piece workers. Salaries increased by \$175,741, wages paid by \$266,786 and outside piece workers by \$7,120. The average salary per employee irrespective of sex was approximately \$1,989 in 1928, whilst in 1929 it fell to \$1,945, or a decrease of a little over 2.2 per cent. The average wage of all employees declined from \$899 in 1928 to \$884 in 1929, or a percentage decrease of 1.7.

In Table 6 the number of employees on the payroll for each month of the year is shown according to sex. Employment reached the maximum in April with a total of 15,646. It was lowest in the month of December when the total employment stood at 13,053. The average enrolment for the year was 4,011 males and 11,058 females, a total of 15,069.

Other Employment Statistics

The number and percentage of wage-earners in months of highest employment working specified hours per day is shown in Table 6(a) for Canada and the provinces. For the Dominion, the number working specified hours was distributed between the classes, the percentage working 9 hours being highest. British Columbia has the highest percentage of employees working 8 hours per diem, whilst in Manitoba, Ontario and Western provinces the 8 hour day prevails. In Quebec over 68 per cent of the wage-earners work 9 hours. In the provinces of Quebec, Ontario and Manitoba only are workers employed for periods exceeding 9 hours a day.

Other Employment Statistics (Cont'd.)

The number of hours worked per day in the month of highest employment and the Standard working hours per week are shown by provinces in Table 6(b). It should be noted that whilst the statistics relating to hours of labour in columns 1, 2 and 3 are based on figures compiled for the month of highest employment, those in columns 4 and 5 represent the total and average of standard weekly hours of labour for the number of establishments reporting to the Bureau. For this reason the relation between daily and weekly hours of labour is to some extent impaired. The average daily hours of labour on the above basis was for the Dominion 8.6, whilst the average standard weekly hours worked out at 45.9 per plant.

Fuel Consumption



Power Installation

The power employed in this industry was wholly electric, and was all purchased, and the number of electric motors reported totalled 1,210 with a rated horsepower of 2,993. Boilers installed for any purpose were 26 in number with a horsepower capacity of 533.

Imports and Exports

Imports and Exports of Women's factory or "ready to wear" clothing are not distinctively specified in the trade returns but are included in the item designated as clothing of cotton, linen, silk and wool, n.o.p., as summarized in Table 9 for the calendar year 1929.

The total value of such imports amounted during this period to \$13,046,713 of which \$4,831,707 came from the United Kingdom, \$4,716,656 from the United States and \$3,498,350 from other countries.
