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WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Ottawa, January, 1932 - A report on the Women's Factory Clothing industry in Canada during the calendar year 1930 is presented herewith. The industry comprises women's clothing, ladies and children's wear, women's neckwear and fancy goods, embroidery and trimmings, laces, tapes and bindings. Reports were received from 455 establishments as shown in the following summary table which gives the number of establishments by classes and their location by provinces.

To prevent disclosure of information regarding the operations of individual establishments, statistics for New Brunswick (3) and Nova Scotia (1) have been combined and are shown throughout this report under the heading of "Maritime Provinces."

As shown in Table 2, the output of the women's factory clothing industry in 1930 amounted to \$61,815,948. The 455 establishments comprising this industry reported a capital investment of \$23,432,441, they furnished employment to 16,782 persons who were paid \$16,483,011 in salaries and wages and paid out \$35,759,351 for materials. The general depression prevailing in 1930 affected this industry very little. Compared with the previous year there was a decrease of 6 establishments with a decrease of \$1,655,421 in the capital invested. The value of production diminished by \$4,530,469 or 6.3 per cent while the number of persons employed was only 242 or 1.4 per cent lower than in the previous year.

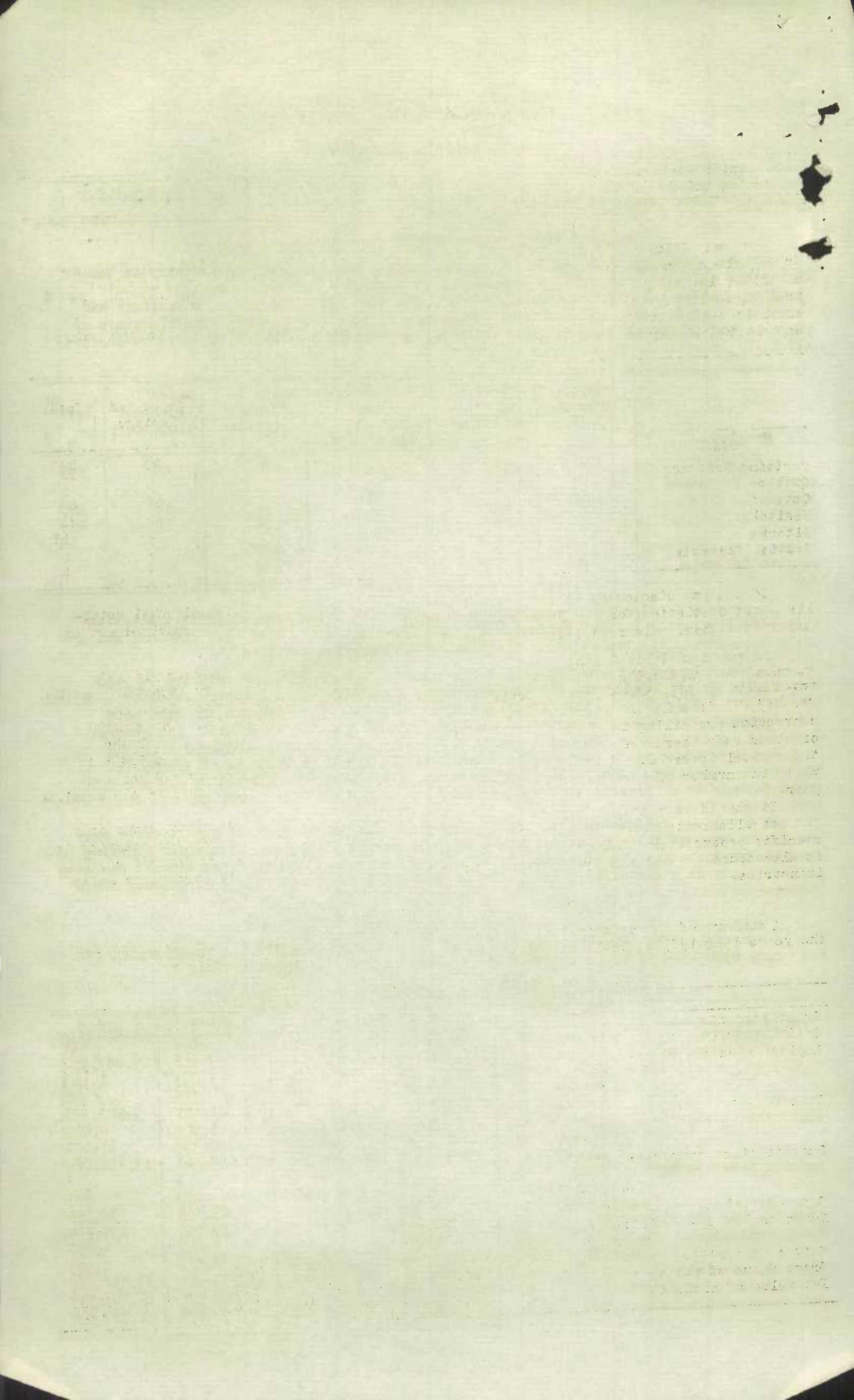
It should be remembered that the figures published in the present report cover only the establishments whose principal products were women's clothing. Statistics relating to specific products are therefore not to be regarded as comprehensive since women's clothing is also found as a secondary product of the "Men's Clothing" and "Men's Furnishing Goods" industries.

Principal Statistics

A summary of the principal statistics of the industry is given for the Dominion for the years 1926-1929 in Table 1, and by provinces for the year 1930 in Table 2.

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WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Size of Establishments

In view of the tendency toward concentration in industrial enterprise a series of tables has been prepared presenting in a threefold way the size of the establishments in the women's factory clothing industry measured by (a) capital investment, (b) gross value of production and (c) the number of persons employed, all within certain specified groups or limitations for the calendar years 1929 and 1930. The tables further serve to indicate the movement of capital, production and employment within the industry.

In 1930 the number of establishments reporting was 455 with a total capital investment of \$23,432,441, a gross value of production of \$61,815,948 and a total employment of 16,782. In capital investment 4 establishments had a capital investment of \$3,410,007 or 14.5 per cent of the total investment and an average investment per establishment of \$852,502. In gross value of production 14 establishments had a total of \$16,545,124 or 26.8 per cent of the total value of production and an average output per establishment of \$1,181,795. In employment 4 establishments had a combined payroll of 3,149 or 18.8 per cent of the total employment, and an average employment per establishment of 787.2.

WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Production

The selling value of the principal products of the industry is given by provinces in Table 3 for the calendar year 1930. The total value of production fell from \$66,346,417 in 1929 to \$61,815,948 in 1930, a net decrease of \$4,530,469 over the two year period. By provinces Quebec leads with a gross value of all products of \$30,055,139 followed by Ontario with \$28,876,839, Manitoba takes third place with \$1,991,262, whilst in fourth position, British Columbia accounted for \$520,190, the remaining \$372,518 being contributed by the Maritime Provinces and Alberta.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital employed in the industry during 1930 is shown by kinds and provinces in Table 5. Fixed capital which includes land, buildings, machinery and tools fell from \$4,887,978 in 1929 to \$4,680,854 in 1930, a decrease of \$207,124.

Working capital which includes materials, supplies and stocks on hand, together with cash, trading and operating accounts, etc., decreased during that period from \$20,199,884 to \$18,751,587, a decrease of \$1,448,297.

Employment Statistics

Statistics relating to employment will be found in Tables 6 and 7. Table 6 shows the number of persons employed by classes, sex and remuneration as well as by provinces. Compared with 1929 there were decreases in employment of 54 in the salaried class, of 188 in the wage earning class and of 259 in the number of outside piece workers. Salaries decreased by \$172,280, wages paid by \$473,130 and outside piece workers by \$1,673.

In Table 7 the number of employees on the payroll for each month of the year is shown according to sex. Employment reached the maximum in March with a total of 15,859. It was lowest in the month of December when the total employment stood at 12,756. The average enrolment for the year was 4,041 males and 10,840 females, a total of 14,881.

Fuel Consumption

The quantity and cost value of the fuel consumed in the industry during 1930 is shown in Table 8. The cost of electricity purchased during the year was \$117,756 as compared with \$94,820 in 1929.

Power Installation

The power employed in this industry was wholly electric, and was all purchased, and the number of electric motors reported totalled 1,236 with a rated horsepower of 2,549. Boilers installed for any purpose were 22 in number with a horsepower capacity of 440.

Imports and Exports

Imports and Exports of Women's factory or "ready to wear" clothing are not distinctively specified in the trade returns but are included in the item designated as clothing of cotton, linen, silk and wool, n.o.p., as summarized in Table 9 for the calendar year 1930.

The total value of such imports amounted during this period to \$9,757,612 of which \$3,315,370 came from the United Kingdom, \$3,774,896 from the United States and \$2,667,346 from other countries.

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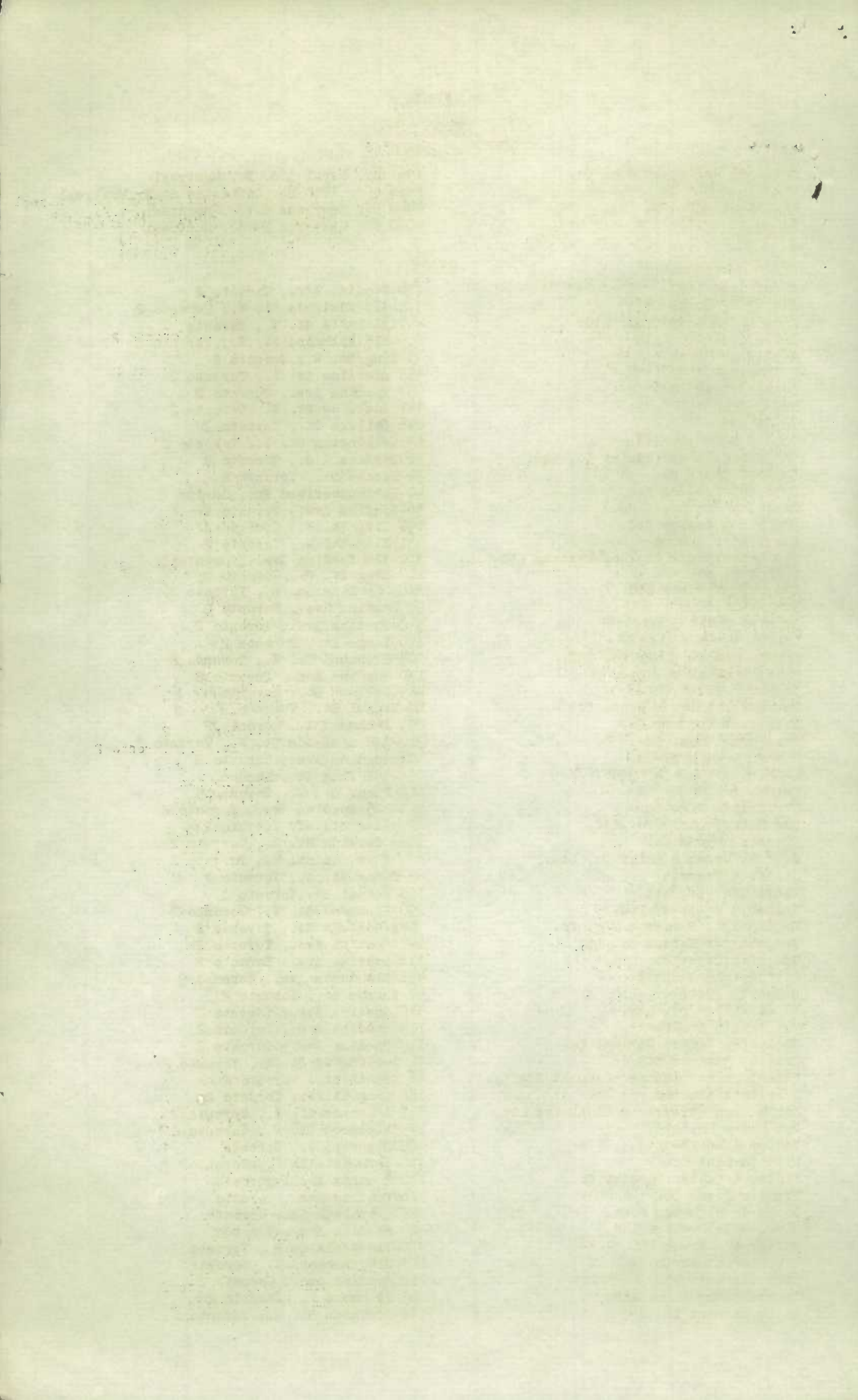

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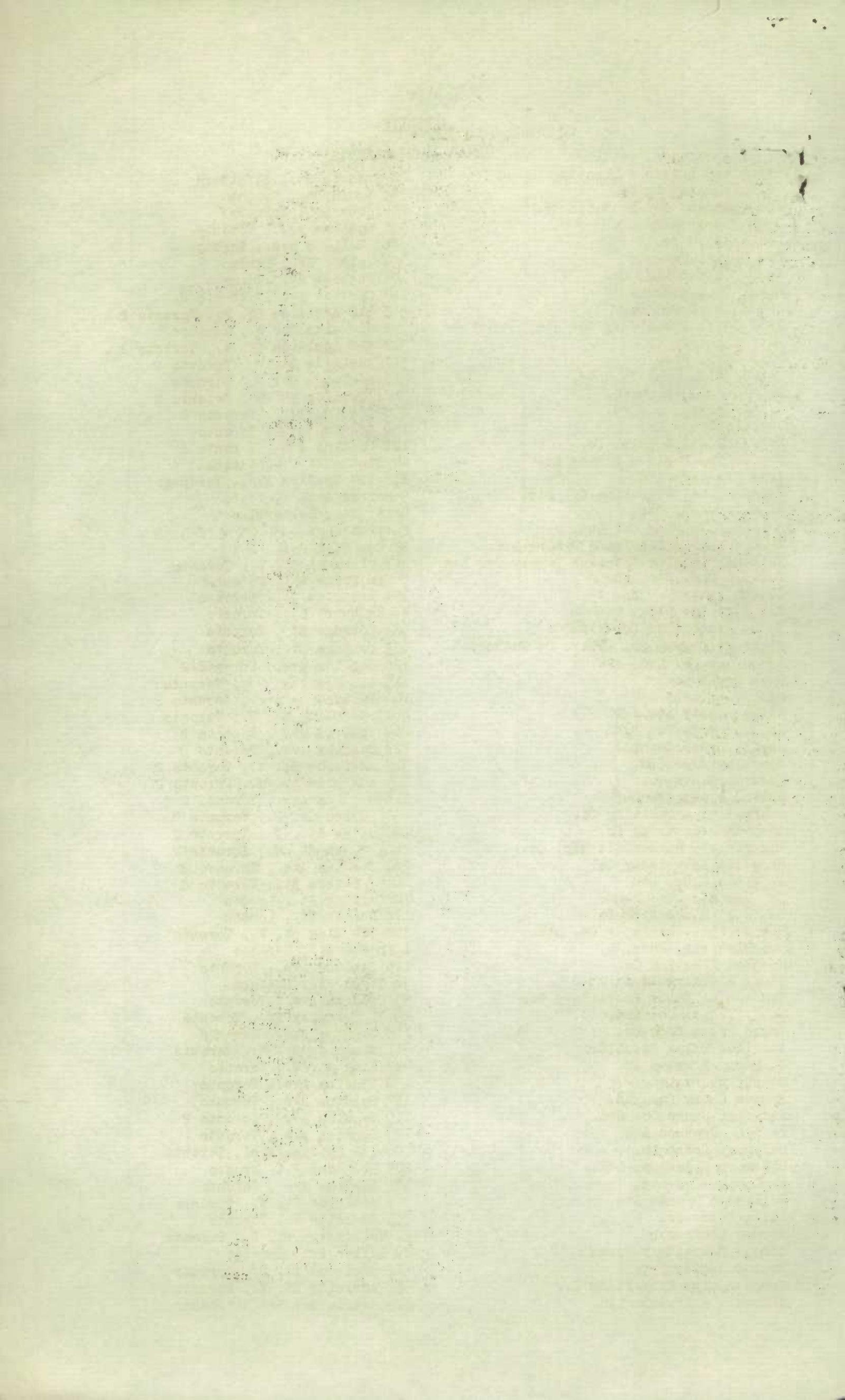
