

NOTE.— The statistics published in this report include only the statistics of the manufacturing establishments whose principal products are women's factory clothing and allied products. Statistics relating to specific products such as dresses, blouses, underwear, nightwear, neckwear, etc., are not to be regarded as comprehensive, as they are also produced in the Men's Factory Clothing, Men's Furnishing Goods, Hosiery and Knitted Goods, Silk and other Industries.

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1932.

In 1932 reports were received from 461 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was a decrease of ten from the number reporting in 1931.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The different divisions manufacture (1) women's factory clothing, (2) ladies' and children's wear, (3) women's neckwear and fancy goods, (4) embroideries and trimmings and (5) laces, tapes and bindings. The principal statistics of all these divisions are contained in table 4.

This industry showed a drastic decline in manufacturing operations in 1932 compared with 1931. Gross value of production was \$42,564,589, a decrease of \$11,576,181 or 21.4 per cent. Capital investment, amounting to \$18,147,033, declined by \$3,283,950 or 15.3 per cent. The number of employees, salaried and wage-earning, dropped to 14,276, which was 1,372 or 8.8 per cent fewer persons employed than in 1931. Their salaries and wages totalled \$12,117,879, a decrease of \$2,900,316 or 12.3 per cent. The cost of all materials used was \$23,983,585, a drop of \$6,972,388 or 22.5 per cent, while the value added by manufacture, \$18,581,004, declined by \$4,603,793 or 19.9 per cent. These actual variations in the principal statistics of 1932 in comparison with 1931 are shown herewith by provinces.

The establishments reporting in 1932 were distributed by provinces as follows:- Quebec 221, Ontario 201, Manitoba twenty-four, British Columbia ten, Alberta three and New Brunswick two. The percentage distribution of the principal statistics for 1931 and 1932 are shown in the following table, and it will be noted that the province of Quebec accounted for more than half the value of production in both years.

Production in this industry showed a considerable decline in 1932, and it was fairly general with all articles manufactured. A complete list of all products for both 1931 and 1932 is contained in table 5.

The materials used by this industry were not collected in detail in 1932. The total cost by provinces is shown in table 1.

Capital investment showed a drop of \$3,283,950 in 1932, all of which occurred in working capital; the decrease being divided fairly equally between the three component items.

This industry is becoming concentrated in fewer and larger establishments. By referring to table 7, it will be noted that 123 of the 461 establishments accounted for \$30,025,776 or 70.5 per cent of the total value of production, that ninety-one establishments supplied \$12,266,096 or 67.6 per cent of the capital investment, and employment was furnished by sixty-eight establishments to 7,823 persons or 54.8 per cent of the total number employed.

The average number of wage-earners declined by 1,260 in 1932. March was the month of highest employment in this year with 13,877 wage-earners and December with 9,943 was the lowest. In 1931, April with 14,920 was the highest and December with 11,748 was the lowest.

For example, a firm whose production is composed of \$100,000 worth of women's clothing and \$5,000 worth of embroideries and trimmings is placed in the "women's factory clothing" section, whereas a firm producing \$25,000 worth of embroideries and trimmings and \$10,000 worth of women's clothing would be placed in the "embroideries and trimmings" section.


