NOTE.- The statistics published in this report include only the statistics of the manufacturing establishments whose principal products are women's factory clothing and allied products. Statistics relating to specific products such as dresses, blouses, underwear, nightwear, neckwear, etc., are not to be regarded as comprehensive, as they are also produced in the Men's Factory Clothing, Men's Furnishing Goods, Hosiery and Knitted Goods, Silk and other Industries.

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1933.

In 1933 reports were received from 540 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 79 over the number reporting in 1932.

This industry is composed of 5 divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) women's factory clothing, (2) ladies' and children's wear, (3) women's neckwear and fancy goods, (4) embroideries and trimmings and (5) laces, tapes and bindings. The principal statistics of all these divisions are contained in table 4.

Due to the increase of 79 in the number of firms reporting and the improvement which has taken place in 1933 there was an increase of \$1,971,234 in the gross value of production over the amount recorded for the previous year. The capital investment however fell from \$18,147,033 in 1932 to \$18,132,022 in 1933 a decrease of \$15,011. The total number of employees rose from 14,276 in 1932 to 15,264, an increase of 988. The total payroll however diminished to the extent of \$288,901. Additional expense amounting to \$1,901,488 was incurred in the cost of materials used, whilst the value added by manufacture showed an increase of \$69,746 over the two year period. The following table shows the variations in the principal statistics, by provinces, in comparison with the year 1932.

The establishments reporting in 1933 were located by provinces as follows:- Quebec 267, Ontario 234, Manitoba 21, British Columbia 12, Alberta 4, New Brunswick 2. To avoid disclosure of information concerning individual establishments the provinces of Alberta and New Brunswick have been combined and are shown throughout this report as "Other provinces". The percentage distribution of the principal statistics for the years 1932 and 1933 are shown in the following table and it will be noted that the province of Quebec accounted for more than half the total value of production in both years.
