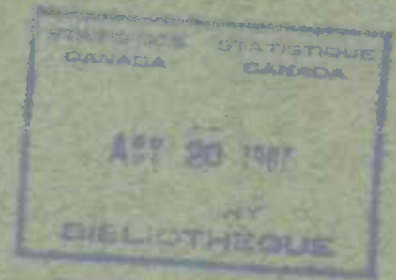

NOTE.- The statistics published in this report include only the statistics of the manufacturing establishments whose principal products are women's factory clothing and allied products. Statistics relating to specific products such as dresses, blouses, underwear, nightwear, neckwear, etc., are not to be regarded as the total for Canada, as they are also produced in the Men's Factory Clothing, Men's Furnishing Goods, Hosiery and Knitted Goods, Silk and other Industries.

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1935.

In 1935 reports were received from 591 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of fourteen over the number reporting in 1934.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) women's factory clothing, (2) ladies' and children's wear, (3) women's neckwear and fancy goods, (4) embroideries and trimmings, and (5) laces, tapes and bindings. The principal statistics of all these divisions are contained in table 4.

Due to the increase of fourteen in the number of firms reporting and the improvement which continued throughout 1935, there was an increase of \$2,263,183 in the gross value of production over the amount recorded for the previous year. The capital investment rose from \$19,389,407 in 1934 to \$22,668,528 in 1935, an increase of \$3,279,121. The total number of employees rose from 17,000 in 1934 to 17,894, an increase of 894. The total payroll also expanded to the extent of \$1,002,730. Additional expense, amounting to \$1,168,538, was incurred in the cost of materials used.

The establishments reporting in 1935 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 312, Ontario 236, Manitoba 22, British Columbia 14, Alberta 4, New Brunswick 2 and Saskatchewan 1. To avoid disclosure of information concerning individual establishments the provinces of Alberta, Saskatchewan and New Brunswick have been combined and are shown throughout this report as "Other Provinces".
