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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1938.

In 1938 reports were received from 605 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 12 over the number reporting in 1937.

This industry is composed of six divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Womens cloaks and suits, (2) Womens dresses and suits, (3) Ladies wear, (4) Childrens wear, (5) Laces, tapes and bindings, (6) Embroidery, pleating and hem-stitching.

There was a decrease of \$3,338,802 in the gross value of production over the amount recorded for the previous year. The capital investment fell from \$26,734,768 in 1937 to \$26,254,827 in 1938, a decrease of \$479,941. The total number of employees fell from 19,981 in 1937 to 19,909, a decrease of 72, but the total payroll expanded to the extent of \$58,075. A decline, amounting to \$2,868,673 was recorded in the cost of materials used.

The establishments reporting in 1938 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 337, Ontario 220, Manitoba 24, British Columbia 17, Alberta 4, New Brunswick 3.
