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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1940.

In 1940 reports were received from 604 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 29 over the number reporting in 1939.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Womens cloaks and suits, (2) Womens dresses, (3) Ladies wear, (4) Childrens wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics." In 1940 there were 604 establishments reporting under the above classifications. They reported a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$29,456,346. They gave employment to 20,549 persons who received \$18,891,-844 in salaries and wages and produced goods with a factory value of \$68,587,845 from materials costing \$40,206,626, leaving the value added by manufacture at \$28,140,669.

The output of the industry was considerably higher in 1940. Compared with the previous year there were increases of \$11,306,179 in the gross value of production, \$3,402,158 in the capital invested, 1,182 in the number of employees, \$2,323,232 in the salaries and wages paid, \$7,428,569 in the cost of materials used and \$3,854,738 in the value added by manufacture.

The establishments reporting in 1940 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 334, Ontario 221, Manitoba 25, British Columbia 16, Alberta 5, and New Brunswick 3.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1940 the establishments located there produced 66 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 48 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 19 per cent, "ladies' wear" 18 per cent and "childrens wear" 10 per cent. Toronto with 24 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.
