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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1943.

In 1943 reports were received from 781 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 6 over the number reporting in 1942.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Women's coats and suits, (2) Women's dresses, (3) Ladies wear, (4) Children's wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics." In 1943 there were 781 establishments reporting under the above classification. They reported a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$44,299,242. They gave employment to 25,752 persons who received \$32,385,477 in salaries and wages and produced goods with a factory value of \$124,837,789 from materials costing \$69,264,831 leaving the value added by manufacture at \$55,271,412.

The output of the industry was somewhat lower in 1943. However, due to increased selling values at the factory, the value of products made increased by \$8,658,709. Also reflected in the lower volume of production is the decline of 576 in the number of persons employed. Salaries and wages paid were nevertheless \$2,347,920 higher. There was also an increase of \$5,744,442 in the value added by manufacture.

The establishments reporting in 1943 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 459, Ontario 265, Manitoba 27, British Columbia 20, Alberta 6, New Brunswick 3 and Saskatchewan 1. To avoid disclosure of information relating to individual establishments statistics for the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan have been combined.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1943 the establishments located there produced 66 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 82 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 43 per cent, "ladies wear" 63 per cent and "childrens wear" 76 per cent. Toronto with 25 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.

SECTION 11. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1943.

In this branch of the clothing industry, reports were received from 61 establishments of which 48 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, and 13 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity. The total value of work performed during 1943 was \$1,704,387. The capital investment was \$458,423, whilst there were 1,171 persons employed who received \$1,225,885 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$61,297 in 1943. Tables 14 to 21 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.
