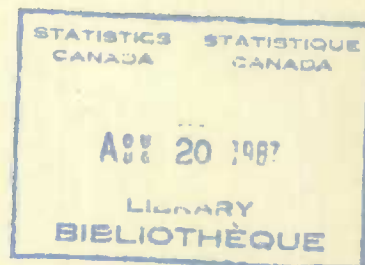

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1944

In 1944 reports were received from 835 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 54 over the number reporting in 1943.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Women's coats and suits, (2) Women's dresses, (3) Ladies wear, (4) Children's wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics". In 1944 there were 835 establishments reporting under the above classification. They furnished employment to 25,810 persons who received \$34,669,358 in salaries and wages and produced goods with a factory value of \$133,966,487 from materials costing \$72,815,459 leaving the value added by manufacture at \$60,839,942.

The physical output of the industry was somewhat lower in 1944. However, due to increased selling values at the factory, the value of products made increased by \$9,128,698 or 7.3 per cent. There was also an increase of 58 in the number of persons employed and \$2,283,881 in the salaries and wages paid. Of the increase of \$5,568,530 in the value added by manufacture \$2,283,881 was passed along in increased salary and wage payments to employees.

The establishments reporting in 1944 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 499, Ontario 276, Manitoba 29, British Columbia 21, Alberta 6, New Brunswick 3 and Saskatchewan 1. To avoid disclosure of information relating to individual establishments statistics for the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan have been combined.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1944 the establishments located there produced 66 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 81 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 42 per cent, "ladies wear" 67 per cent and "children's wear" 71 per cent. Toronto with 25 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.

SECTION 11. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1944

In this branch of the clothing industry, reports were received from 63 establishments of which 50 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, and 13 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity. The total value of work performed during 1944 was \$1,837,563. There were also 1,209 persons employed who received \$1,334,235 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$57,088 in 1944. Tables 14 to 21 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.
