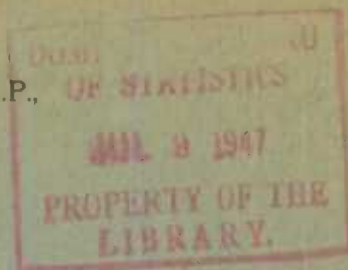

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1945

In 1945 reports were received from 989 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 154 over the number reporting in 1944.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Women's coats and suits, (2) Women's dresses, (3) Ladies' wear, (4) Children's wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics". In 1945 there were 989 establishments reporting under the above classification. They furnished employment to 27,975 persons who received \$39,485,827 in salaries and wages and produced goods with a factory value of \$148,827,882 from materials costing \$78,385,452 leaving the value added by manufacture at \$70,099,770.

The physical volume of women's factory clothing was 2.6 per cent higher in 1945 than in the previous year. However, due to increased selling values at the factory, the gross value of production increased by \$14,861,395 or 11.1 per cent. There was also an increase of 2,165 in the number of persons employed and \$4,816,469 in the salaries and wages paid. Of the increase of \$9,259,828 in the value added by manufacture \$4,816,469 was passed along in increased salary and wage payments to employees.

The establishments reporting in 1945 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 611, Ontario 312, Manitoba 34, British Columbia 21, Alberta 7, New Brunswick 3 and Saskatchewan 1. To avoid disclosure of information relating to individual establishments statistics for the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan have been combined.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1945 the establishments located there produced 66 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 81 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 42 per cent, "ladies wear" 62 per cent and "children's wear" 74 per cent. Toronto with 25 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.

SECTION 11. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1945

In this branch of the clothing industry, reports were received from 72 establishments of which 56 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, and 16 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity. The total value of work performed during 1945 was \$2,078,298. There were also 1,260 persons employed who received \$1,510,723 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$63,769 in 1945. Tables 14 to 21 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.
