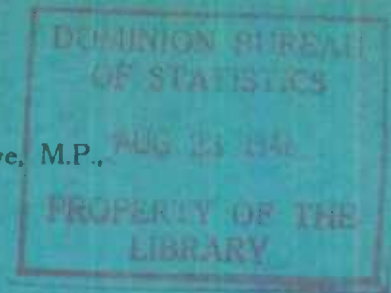


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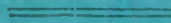

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1946

In 1946 reports were received from 1,108 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 119 over the number reporting in 1945.

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Women's coats and suits, (2) Women's dresses, (3) Ladies' wear, (4) Children's wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics". In 1946 there were 1,108 establishments reporting under the above classification. They furnished employment to 29,963 persons who received \$44,985,178 in salaries and wages and produced goods with a factory value of \$174,353,223 from materials costing \$91,138,141, leaving the value added by manufacture at \$82,818,768.

The physical volume of women's factory clothing was 2.8 per cent higher in 1946 than in the previous year. However, due to increased selling values at the factory, the gross value of production increased by \$25,525,341 or 17.2 per cent. There was also an increase of 1,988 in the number of persons employed and \$5,499,351 in the salaries and wages paid. Of the increase of \$12,718,998 in the value added by manufacture \$5,499,351 was passed along in increased salary and wage payments to employees.

The establishments reporting in 1946 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 702, Ontario 335, Manitoba 38, British Columbia 21, Alberta 8, New Brunswick 3 and Saskatchewan 1. To avoid disclosure of information relating to individual establishments statistics for the provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan have been combined.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1946 the establishments located there produced 66 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 82 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 44 per cent, "ladies wear" 64 per cent and "children's wear" 72 per cent. Toronto with 24 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.

SECTION II. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1946.

In this branch of the clothing industry, reports were received from 100 establishments of which 70 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, 29 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity and 1 in Manitoba. The total value of work performed during 1946 was 2,849,836. There were 1,700 persons employed who received \$2,012,027 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$170,924 in 1946. Tables 16 to 23 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.
