


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

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THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1947

This industry is composed of five divisions, so closely allied as to make it impracticable to treat each one as a separate industry. The divisions comprise (1) Women's coats and suits, (2) Women's dresses, (3) Ladies' wear, (4) Children's wear, (5) Embroidery, pleating and hemstitching. Laces, tapes and bindings which previous to 1938 comprised a division, are now classified as a separate industry under the title "Narrow Fabrics".

In 1947 reports were received from 1,169 establishments engaged primarily in the manufacture of women's factory clothing and ready-to-wear garments which was an increase of 61 over the number reporting in 1946. These establishments had a gross value of production amounting to \$184,305,430. Employment was given to 30,969 persons who were paid in salaries and wages the sum of \$50,357,121. The cost of materials used was \$92,713,574 and the value added by manufacture amounted to \$91,158,213.

When compared with the previous year, the gross value of the industry's output increased by \$9,952,207 or 5.7 per cent. Employment was provided for 1,006 more persons, an increase of 3.4 per cent, and the disbursement in salaries and wages was greater by \$5,371,943 or 11.9 per cent. The cost of materials used in 1947 exceeded that reported for 1946 by \$1,575,433 or 1.7 per cent. The value added by manufacture increased by \$8,339,445, \$5,371,943 of which was passed along in larger salary and wage payments to employees.

The establishments reporting in 1947 were located by provinces as follows: Quebec 742, Ontario 352, Manitoba 43, British Columbia 21, Alberta 8, New Brunswick 2 and Saskatchewan 1.

Montreal is the centre of the industry. In 1947 the establishments located there produced 64 per cent of the total output of the women's factory clothing industry. Establishments classified in the "dress" section produced 79 per cent of the total, "coats and suits" 43 per cent, "ladies wear" 64 per cent and "children's wear" 64 per cent. Toronto with 24 per cent of the total for the industry ranked second. The following table gives the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of products.

SECTION II. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1947

In this branch of the clothing industry reports were received from 94 establishments of which 65 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, 27 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity, and 2 in Manitoba. The total value of work performed during 1947 was \$2,427,230. There were 1,405 persons employed who received \$1,771,520 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$102,682 in 1947. Tables 16 to 23 inclusive cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.


