SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1951

The present report is divided into four sections as follows:

1. Combined women's and children's factory clothing industries, 2. Women's factory clothing industry, 3. Children's factory clothing industry and 4. Women's and children's factory clothing contractors. The development in these industries for 1951 will be noted in their respective sections and the list of firms in each category follows at the end of the separate sections. The first section provides the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries.

The gross value of production of the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries rose from \$224,034,855 in 1950 to \$231,519,274 in 1951, a monetary increase of \$7,484,419 or 3 per cent. However the industry in general remained in a depressed state and employment fell slightly. There was one significant exception to this trend in the sportswear field. This development has led to the production of wide varieties of sports clothing. Makers of work clothes have turned to such articles as blue jeans, dungarees and denim shorts. Expansion has occurred in the production of such items as halters and matching shorts and sun dresses for beach wear. Blouse manufacturers are making skirts to match in order to follow the trend.

The women's and children's factory clothing industries continued to suffer in 1951 as consumer expenditure tended more toward durable goods. More money, too, continued to be spent on food and shelter. A further cause of difficulty was the weather and the combination of an early Easter, a late spring and a mild summer reduced the traditional clothing demand as well as tending to upset the usual seasonal pattern.

The value of materials consumed by these industries rose from \$118,649,166 in 1950 to

\$120,202,123 in 1951. Employment showed a slight decrease from 34,486 to 34,343 over the same period and salaries and wages increased from \$64,145,262 in 1950 to \$65,937,382 in 1951.

In Table 2 will be found a comparison of the principal parts of the women's and children's clothing industries. The gross value of production of women's dresses rose from \$73,384,592 in 1950 to \$75,422,512 in 1951. Women's coats and suits declined from \$56,761,155 in 1950 to \$54,668,223 in the year under review and other women's outerwear and underwear rose from \$64,490,722 to \$67,660,199.

Of the combined industry's output of \$231,519,274 in 1951, \$150,481,388 or 65 per cent was accounted for by Montreal and \$47,735,184 or 21 per cent by Toronto. There were 1,068 establishments in these industries in 1951 of which 3 were in New Brunswick, 656 in Quebec, 335 in Ontario, 38 in Manitoba, 4 in Saskatchewan, 6 in Alberta and 26 in British Columbia.

Exports of clothing and furnishings rose from \$825,474 in 1950 to \$1,248,612 in 1951. The exports of women's and children's wool outer garments, n.o.p. rose from \$506,038 in 1950 to \$547,577 in 1951. The exports of cotton clothing, n.o.p. rose from \$52,511 to \$149,638 over the same period and the exports of synthetic fibre dresses advanced from \$33,196 to \$114,868. Imports of clothing and furnishings advanced from \$33,233,145 in 1950 to \$43,185,861 in 1951. The imports of knitted garments, n.o.p. showed an increase from \$5,177,524 in 1950 to \$6,193,056 in 1951. The imports of lace, embroideries, nets, netting and bobinet, n.o.p. rose from \$1,493,972 to \$2,463,099 over the same period. There was also a substantial rise in clothing of synthetic fibre from \$769,024 in 1950 to \$1,228,861 in 1951. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1951

The gross value of production of the women's factory clothing industry in 1951 was \$197,750,934, a rise of \$3,114,465 or 1.6 per cent over the \$194,636,469 reported in 1950. However, the cost of materials showed a slight reduction from \$102,712,875 in 1950 to \$102,135,519 in 1951. Employment showed a drop from 28,981 to 28,688 in the same period while salaries and wages rose from \$55,864,122 to \$56,764,282. Of the 912 establishments in the industry in 1951, 524 were located in Montreal, 268 in Toronto, 32 in Winnipeg, 23 in Vancouver and 65 in all other cities.

Of the five sections comprising the industry, four showed increases in gross value of production while one showed a decrease. Women's coats and suits showed a drop from \$56,761,155 in 1950 to \$54,668,223 in 1951. Women's dresses rose from \$73,384,592 to \$75,422,512 in the same period. The section comprising skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets reported a gain from \$24,594,568 in 1950 to \$26,817,118 in 1951. The section made up of other outerwear also reported an increase from \$14,716,768 to \$15,640,528. The section classified as lingerie increased from \$25,179,386 to \$25,202,553 over the two years. Of the total value of production in 1951, 38 per cent was accounted for by the division producing dresses and 28 per cent by the division pro-

ducing coats and suits. The industry as a whole largely concentrated in Montreal, Toronto and Winnipeg with \$127,968,541 or 65 per cent of the gross value of production in Montreal.

In 1951 a group of twenty-one establishments, each with a value of production in excess of \$1,000,000, accounted for \$30,189,930 or 15 per cent of total value of production. Of the 912 establishments in the industry, 475 had an output between \$100,000 and \$500,000. The employment of wage-earners varied from a high of 26,703 in March to a low of 21,694 in December. A large proportion of wage-earners were female who numbered 75 per cent of total wage-earners in 1951.

Exports of clothing are not large in relation to the Canadian market but exports, including both women's and children's clothing, showed an increase from \$825,474 in 1950 to \$1,248,612 in 1951. The chief articles exported consisted of wool and cotton outer garments. The chief imports in 1951 comprised miscellaneous knitted garments, lace and embroideries, wool outer garments, cotton handkerchiefs and clothing of synthetic fiber. For full details of exports and imports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1951

In 1951 the children's factory clothing industry operated at a higher level in terms of value of production and employment. But the growth of employment was not as rapid as it had been in previous years. The gross value of production was up from \$29,398,386 in 1950 to \$33,768,340 in 1951, a gain of \$4,369,954 or 15 per cent. The cost of materials was up by \$2,130,313 from \$15,936,291 in 1950 to \$18,066,604 in 1951. Employment was up from 5,505 in 1950 to 5,655 in the year under review while salaries and wages rose from \$8,281,140 to \$9,173,100.

Of the 156 establishments in the industry, 102 were in Quebec, 48 in Ontario and 6 in Manitoba. The industry is largely concentrated in three cities. There were 89 establishments in Montreal producing goods to the value of \$22,512,847 or 67 per cent of the total value of the industry. Toronto accounted

for \$4,104,295 or 12 per cent of total value of production and Winnipeg produced goods to the value of \$1,771,322 or 5 per cent of total output.

There were 6 establishments in the industry with a value of production in excess of \$1,000,000 and this group accounted for 24 per cent of total output or \$7,999,116. There was little seasonal variation in the industry in 1951 and monthly employment of wage-earners reached a maximum in March with 5,422 and a minimum in December with 4,498. Females provide much of the labour in this industry, the proportion of female wage-earners being 81 per cent in 1951.

Canadian trade classifications in general do not separate women's and children's clothing. For a detailed list of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. Women's and Children's Clothing Contractors, 1951

In the women's and children's clothing contracting industry, reports were received from 82 contractors and the gross value of work performed reached \$4,141,163. These contractors were mostly established in Quebec and Ontario with two in Manitoba. They employed 1,855 persons who received in salaries and wages the sum of \$2,700,399. The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$170,537 in 1951.

Of the total value of work performed, \$2,634,024 or over 63 per cent was accounted for by Montreal and 4 per cent or \$178,815 by Toronto. Montreal accounted for 60 per cent of salaries and wages and 48 per cent of employees. The monthly employment of wage-earners in the industry ranged from a high of 1,857 in May to a low of 1,460 in December. Female labour accounted for 88 per cent of total wage-earners in 1951.
