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

SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1952

Commencing with 1952, the value of factory shipments f.o.b. plant has been collected in place of gross value of production for the women's and children's factory clothing industries. The value of shipments was substituted for value of production in all industries where inventory change was known to be insignificant and where, therefore, factory shipments approximate production. However, they will not be exactly comparable and this fact must be kept in mind when comparisons are made with earlier years. The changeover is expected to provide increased ease in reporting for the majority of plants while at the same time producing more reliable, more meaningful statistics in many cases.

This first section of the report presents the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by this report, namely; the women's factory clothing industry, the children's factory clothing industry, and the women's and children's clothing contractors industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of the firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of the sections.

The factory shipments made by the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries in 1952 has a value f.o.b. plant of \$259,512,924 which compares with a gross value of production of \$231,519,274 in 1951. Inasmuch as the change in inventory of finished goods during the year was an estimated \$279,000, it is evident that there was a substantially increased output in 1952. Recovery from the mild post-Korean slump of 1951 which was first noticeable in February may be attributed to reduction in inventories at both retail and factory levels. Further improvement accompanied the revival of clothing sales at retail level from April onwards with the recovery in retail sales being due to a rise in real disposable income and a relative fall in clothing prices. The relatively high and steady activity of the women's and children's factory clothing industries throughout the year reflected the influence of these and several other less important developments.

The value of materials consumed by these industries rose from \$120,202,123 in 1951 to \$137,007,872 in 1952, an increase of \$16,805,749

or 14 per cent. Employment showed a slight increase from 34,343 to 34,759 over the same period while salaries and wages were up considerably from \$65,937,382 to \$71,029,925, a gain of 8 per cent.

A comparison of the principal divisions of the women's and children's factory clothing industries is presented in Table 2 of this report. The "women's dresses" division continues to be the most important with factory shipments amounting to \$78,953,129 in 1952, followed by "women's coats and suits" with \$55,572,391. The largest gain, both absolutely and percentagewise, was recorded by the "children's clothing" division where value of factory shipments advanced from \$33,768,340 in 1951 to \$42,071,853 in 1952, an increase of \$8,303,513 or 25 per cent.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses of which 6,878,050 valued at \$48,127,899 were shipped. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were the following women's and misses' garments: wool coats, 1,574,041 valued at \$37,284,767; wool suits, 519,775 at \$12,770,944; cotton dresses, fine, 1,899,067 at \$8,898,967; rayon slips and petticoats, 428,776 dozen at \$7,938,280 and cotton housedresses, 4,060,621 at \$7,274,125.

Imports of clothing and furnishings rose from \$43,185,861 in 1951 to \$51,645,311 in 1952. Exports fell slightly from \$1,248,612 to \$1,158,554 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

In 1952 there were 1,017 establishments in the two industries distributed provincially as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 634, Ontario 315, Manitoba 33, Saskatchewan 4, Alberta 5 and British Columbia 23. There is heavy concentration in Montreal and Toronto, the two cities together accounting for 81 per cent of employment and 83 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant with 20,654 employees and shipments valued at \$164,344,027, 60 and 63 per cent respectively, while Toronto accounted for 7,437 employees and shipments of \$51,536,462, 21 and 20 per cent respectively. The following table gives, by sections, the standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of factory shipments.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1952

The factory selling value of the products shipped by the women's factory clothing industry in 1952 amounted to \$217,441,071. The collection of the value of factory shipments instead of gross value of production as in former years is dealt with in the text of Section 1. In view of what is said there and the fact that change in inventory of finished products amounted to only an estimated \$153,000, the figure of \$217,441,071 compares very favorably with the gross value of production of \$197,750,934 reported by the industry in 1951 and indicates a higher level of activity in the year under review. The upswing was first noticeable in February and once underway was sustained by the strong recovery in retail clothing sales from April onwards.

The increased output was achieved with a slightly lower employment, 28,433 in 1952 against 28,688 in 1951, but the payroll of \$60,193,172 was higher by \$3,428,890 or 6 per cent. The cost of materials consumed also increased, rising by \$11,343,867 or 11 per cent to \$113,479,386.

The industry in 1952 was comprised of 853 establishments distributed as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 525, Ontario 266, Manitoba 27, Saskatchewan 4, Alberta 5 and British Columbia 23. The location of 499 and 247 establishments respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration of the industry in the two cities. Montreal accounted for 60 per cent of the employment and 63 per cent of the value of factory shipments.

Five more or less distinct sections comprise the women's factory clothing industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 9. The "dresses" section is considerably larger than any of the others and in the year under review made shipments valued at \$78,953,129 or 36 per cent of the total. Montreal, the centre of the dress industry, reported \$62,797,971 or 80 per cent of this amount. The "coats and suits" section ranked second in value of shipments with \$55,572,391 followed by "skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets" with \$34,866,299, "lingerie" with \$30,468,703 and "other outerwear" with \$17,580,549.

Table 11A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made in the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of the classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 18A shows a like situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish detail in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports on the other hand have been steadily growing and now represent a sizable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, in Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1952

The decision of the Bureau to adopt a shipments concept for 1952 and subsequent years has been dealt with in Section 1. For this first year the children's factory clothing industry reported factory shipments which had a value f.o.b. plant of \$42,071,853. Inasmuch as the change of inventory for the industry was an estimated \$126,000, this amount compares very favorably with the \$33,768,340 gross value of production reported in 1951 and suggests a growth approximating 25 per cent. There were 8 new establishments in 1952. Employment was up from 5,655 in 1951 to 6,326 in 1952 while salaries and wages rose from \$9,173,100 to \$10,836,753 over the two years. The cost of materials consumed rose from \$18,066,604 to \$23,528,486, an increase of 30 per cent.

Of the 164 establishments operating in the industry, 109 were in Quebec, 49 in Ontario and 6 in Manitoba. The industry is largely concentrated in three cities. Montreal with 90 establishments shipped goods with a value of \$26,671,522 or 63 per cent of the total for the industry. Toronto

accounted for \$5,318,287 or 13 per cent and Winnipeg for \$1,960,236 or almost 5 per cent.

Table 18A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made in the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 11A shows a like situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish details in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1952

This industry in 1952 was comprised of 96 establishments of which 78 were in Quebec, 17 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these contractors was \$4,332,887, a slight increase over the \$4,141,163 reported in 1951. Employment was provided for 2,149 persons who received the sum of \$3,191,448 in salaries and wages. The materials supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc. amounted to \$230,535.

There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of women's and children's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$2,465,834 or 57 per cent of total. They accounted for 48 per cent of the employees and 57 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.
