

SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1953

This first section of the report presents the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by this report, namely; the women's factory clothing industry, the children's factory clothing industry, and the women's and children's clothing contractors industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of the firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of the sections.

The factory shipments made by the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries in 1953 had a value f.o.b. plant of \$265,757,818, up \$6,244,894 or 2.4 per cent from the 1952 figure of \$259,512,924. The absolute increase was about the same for each of the two industries but percentagewise it amounted to 8 per cent in the children's industry compared with only 1.4 per cent in the women's industry. Accompanying the increase in the value of shipments was a slight rise in employment from 34,759 in 1952 to 35,170 in 1953 and a 4 per cent advance in salary and wage payments over the two years from \$71,029,925 to \$73,983,041. The cost of materials consumed in manufacture amounted to \$137,007,872 in 1952 compared with \$140,969,051 in 1953, a 3 per cent increase.

In 1953 there were 999 establishments in the two industries distributed provincially as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 619, Ontario 308, Manitoba 34, Saskatchewan 4, Alberta 7 and British Columbia 24. There is heavy concentration in Montreal and Toronto, the two cities together accounting for 81 per cent of employment and 84 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant with 21,206 employees and shipments valued at \$170,694,163, 60 and 64 per cent respectively, while Toronto accounted for 7,411 employees and shipments of \$51,515,577, 21 and 20 per cent respectively. The standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of factory shipments, by sections, is given in the table at the top of the page following.

A comparison of the principal divisions of the women's and children's factory clothing industries is presented in Table 2 of this report. All divisions

managed an increase in value of factory shipments over the previous year with the exception of "women's dresses" which reported a slight drop. This division continues to be the most important with factory shipments amounting to \$77,614,204 in 1953, followed by "women's coats and suits" with \$56,091,890. The largest gain, both absolutely and percentagewise, was recorded by the "children's clothing" division where value of factory shipments advanced from \$42,071,853 in 1952 to \$45,347,640 in 1953, an increase of \$3,275,787 or about 8 per cent.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses of which 6,520,331 valued at \$48,210,881 were shipped. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were the following women's and misses' garments: wool coats, 1,621,954 valued at \$39,748,086; wool suits, 457,623 at \$11,861,131; cotton dresses, fine, 2,572,571 at \$10,695,932; wool skirts, 1,085,814 at \$6,610,977 and nylon blouses, 210,618 dozens at \$6,569,803.

Imports of clothing and furnishings rose from \$51,741,740 in 1952 to \$61,220,838 in 1953. Exports increased slightly from \$1,158,554 to \$1,285,363 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

Detailed information on the use of fuel and electricity by the two industries and on their power installation will be found in Tables 7 and 8. Prior to 1948 this information was collected annually but since then it is being collected only every fifth year.

Note on 1954.—While the Census of Industry survey is quite incomplete at the time of preparing this report, data from other sources in the Bureau indicate a slight decline in activity in 1954 in the two industries under review. Based on a monthly sample survey, factory shipments for the industries combined are estimated to have fallen to \$253,877,000, a drop of 4 per cent from the 1953 figure. Employment was lower by about 6 per cent according to a monthly survey of all firms with 15 or more employees. Associated with this curtailment of activity at factory level was a very minor reduction in 1954 in retail sales of women's and children's clothing.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1953

The factory selling value of the products shipped by the women's factory clothing industry in 1953 amounted to \$220,410,178. This figure compares favorably with the \$217,441,071 worth of products shipped a year earlier and represents an increase of \$2,969,107 or 1.4 per cent. The increase in shipments was achieved with a slightly lower employment, 28,277 in 1953 against 28,433 in 1952, but the payroll of \$61,838,049 was higher by \$1,644,877 or 2.7 per cent. The cost of materials consumed also increased, rising by \$2,707,502 or 2.4 per cent to \$116,186,888.

The industry in 1953 was comprised of 830 establishments distributed as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 502, Ontario 263, Manitoba 27, Saskatchewan 4, Alberta 7 and British Columbia 24. The location of 474 and 243 establishments respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration of the industry in the two cities. Montreal accounted for 60 per cent of the employment and 64 per cent of the value of factory shipments.

The women's factory clothing industry is made up of establishments of varying sizes. In 1953 a group of 26 establishments, each reporting shipments in excess of \$1,000,000, accounted for \$38,708,350 or 18 per cent of the industry's total shipments. Of the 830 establishments in the industry, 439 shipped goods valued between \$100,000 and \$500,000. From Table 17 it will be seen that there is no marked degree of concentration of output in any one size group.

Five more or less distinct sections comprise the women's factory clothing industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 12.

The "dresses" section is considerably larger than any of the others and in the year under review made shipments valued at \$77,614,204 or 35 per cent of the total. Montreal, the centre of the dress industry, reported \$62,786,954 or 81 per cent of this amount. The "coats and suits" section ranked second in value of shipments with \$56,091,890 followed by "skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets" with \$37,391,177, "lingerie" with \$31,418,255 and "other outerwear" with \$17,894,652.

Table 14A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made in the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of the classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 21A shows a like situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish detail in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports on the other hand have been steadily growing and now represent a sizable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, in Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1953

The Bureau began compiling separate statistics on the children's factory clothing industry in 1937. The history of the industry since that time has been one of continuous growth represented by an unbroken series of annual increments to value of production and, excluding 1941, of yearly increases in employment. The year under review was no exception. In all the usual terms—number of establishments, number of employees, salaries and wage payments, cost of materials consumed and value of output—the industry's activity in this latest year was the highest on record.

The value f.o.b. plant of the factory shipments made by the industry in 1953 amounted to \$45,347,640, an increase of \$3,275,787 or 8 per cent over the \$42,071,853 worth of products shipped in 1952. A rise of 9 per cent in employment from 6326 in the earlier year to 6,893 in the later was accompanied by an 11 per cent increase in salary and wage payments from \$10,836,753 to \$12,144,992. The cost of materials consumed in manufacture cost \$23,528,486 in 1952 compared with \$24,782,163 in 1953.

Of the 169 establishments operating in the industry, 117 were in Quebec, 45 in Ontario and

7 in Manitoba. The industry is largely concentrated in three cities. Montreal with 103 establishments shipped goods with a value of \$29,791,154 or 66 per cent of the total for the industry. Toronto accounted for \$6,006,948 or 13 per cent and Winnipeg for \$1,784,602 or almost 4 per cent.

Table 21A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made in the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 14A shows a like situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish details in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1953

This industry in 1953 was comprised of 107 establishments of which 93 were in Quebec, 13 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these contractors was \$5,399,344, an amount substantially above the \$4,332,887 reported in 1952. Employment was provided for 2,307 persons who received the sum of \$3,598,498 in salaries and wages. The materials supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc. amounted to \$223,364.

There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of women's and children's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$2,763,761 or 51 per cent of total. They accounted for 50 per cent of the employees and 59 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.


