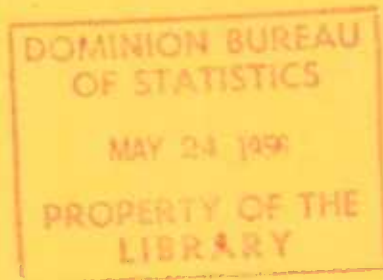

SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1954

This first section of the report presents the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by this report, namely: the women's factory clothing industry, the children's factory clothing industry, and the women's and children's clothing contractors industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of the firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of the sections.

Activity slackened somewhat in the women's and children's factory clothing industries in 1954. Both of the industries reported lessened employment and a lower level for shipments but the reductions were all relatively small. The factory selling value of the products shipped by the two industries in 1954 totalled \$263,039,825. This amount represents a decrease of \$2,717,993 or one per cent from the previous years figure of \$265,757,818. A fall in employment accompanied this decline in the value of shipments. Employees numbered 34,103 in 1954 compared with 35,170 in 1953, down by 3 per cent, while their earnings totalled \$73,567,439 compared with \$73,983,041, only slightly lower. Material costs were also down slightly, being \$139,973,164 in 1954 as against \$140,969,051 in 1953.

In 1954 there were 979 establishments in the two industries distributed provincially as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 603, Ontario 305, Manitoba 35, Saskatchewan 3, Alberta 6 and British Columbia 24. There is heavy concentration in Montreal and Toronto, the two cities together accounting for 81 per cent of employment and 84 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant with 20,784 employees and shipments valued at \$170,729,519, 61 and 65 per cent respectively, while Toronto accounted for 6,967 employees and shipments of \$49,328,321, 20 and 19 per cent respectively. The standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of factory shipments, by sections, is given in the table at the top of the page following.

The women's and children's factory clothing industries are divided along commodity lines into six divisions. In terms of shipments in all instances and of employment in three the four larger of these operated at a lower level in 1954 than in 1953. The two smaller divisions, on the other hand, managed to increase the value of goods shipped in the year under review. The value of factory shipments in 1954 for the six divisions, with 1953 figures in brackets, are as follows: women's dresses, \$77,232,517 (\$77,614,204); women's coats and suits \$53,318,854 (\$56,091,890); children's clothing, \$44,425,468 (\$45,347,640); skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets \$37,090,518. (\$37,391,177); lingerie, \$32,419,781 (\$31,418,255); other outerwear, \$18,552,687 (\$17,894,652). The largest loss, both absolutely and percentage-wise, was suffered in the women's coats and suits section where a 5 per cent drop occurred. Table 2 presents a comparison of the divisions in detail.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses of which 6,253,655 valued at \$44,292,304 were shipped. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were the following women's and misses' garments: wool coats, 1,582,413 valued at \$36,281,941; wool suits, 455,454 at \$11,365,549 and cotton dresses, fine 2,213,442 at \$11,122,362. Children's wool coats followed with shipments of 851,870 worth \$7,323,040. Further detail of shipments is available from Table 3.

Imports of clothing and furnishings fell from \$61,220,838 in 1953 to \$57,118,733 in 1954. Exports increased slightly from \$1,285,363 to \$1,329,129 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

Beginning with 1954, information on the value of year end inventory holdings at plant and plant warehouses is being collected as part of the Annual Census of Industry. This data was formerly collected by a separate survey. The summarized results for the women's factory clothing industry will be found in Table 9 and for the children's factory clothing industry in Table 19.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1934

The level of activity in the women's factory clothing industry in 1954 was slightly lower than in 1953. Factory shipments by the industry had a total value f.o.b. plant of \$218,614,357, less than one per cent below the preceding year's \$220,410,178. The number of employees declined from 28,277 in 1953 to 27,343 in 1954, down 3.3 per cent, while their earnings of \$61,448,428 in the latter year were narrowly lower than the \$61,838,049 received in the former. The cost of materials also decreased slightly, falling from \$116,186,888 in 1953 to \$115,988,150 in 1954. There were 22 fewer establishments in the year under review.

The industry in 1954 was comprised of 808 establishments distributed as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 485, Ontario 259, Manitoba 28, Saskatchewan 3, Alberta 6 and British Columbia 24. The location of 456 and 241 establishments respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration of the industry in the two cities. Montreal accounted for 61 per cent of the employment and 65 per cent of the value of factory shipments.

The women's factory clothing industry is made up of establishments of varying sizes. In 1954 a group of 29 establishments, each reporting shipments in excess of \$1,000,000, accounted for \$41,434,786 or 19 per cent of the industry's total shipments. Of the 808 establishments in the industry, 411 shipped goods valued between \$100,000 and \$500,000. From Table 16 it will be seen that there is no marked degree of concentration of output in any one size group.

Five more or less distinct sections comprise the women's factory clothing industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 11. The "dresses" section is considerably larger than any of the others and in the year under review made shipments valued at \$77,232,517 or 35 per cent of the total. Montreal, the centre of the dress industry, reported \$62,579,220 or 81 per cent of this amount. The "coats and suits" section ranked second in value of shipments with \$53,318,854 followed by "skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets" with \$37,090,518, "lingerie" with \$32,419,781 and "other outerwear" with \$18,552,687.

Table 13A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made in the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 21A shows a like situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish detail in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports on the other hand represent a sizable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, in Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1934

The Bureau began compiling separate statistics on the children's factory clothing industry in 1937. The history of the industry since that time has been one of continuous growth represented by an unbroken series of annual increments to value of production and, excluding 1941, of yearly increases in employment. The first break in this uptrending activity came in 1954 when the number of employees, salary and wage payments, cost of materials and value of factory shipments were all lower than in 1953. The reductions were, however, of small proportions and the level of operations for the year under review was the second highest on record.

The industry reported shipments totalling \$44,425,468 in value in 1954, down 2 per cent from the previous year's \$45,347,640. The number of employees declined 1.9 per cent, 6,760 in 1954 as against 6,893 in 1953, while their earnings were narrowly lower, \$12,119,011 compared with \$12,144,992. A 3.2 per cent fall in material costs from \$24,782,163 in the earlier year to \$23,985,014 in the later accompanied the 2 per cent reduction in the value of factory shipments.

Of the 171 establishments operating in the industry, 118 were in Quebec, 46 in Ontario and

7 in Manitoba. The industry is largely concentrated in three cities. Montreal with 101 establishments shipped goods with a value of \$28,841,894 or 65 per cent of the total for the industry. Toronto accounted for \$5,945,047 or 13 per cent and Winnipeg for \$1,965,030 or over 4 per cent.

Table 21A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made in the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 13A shows a like situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish details in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS' 1954

This industry in 1954 was comprised of 114 establishments of which 98 were in Quebec, 15 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these contractors was \$5,406,735, practically unchanged from the \$5,399,344 reported in 1953. Employment was provided for 2,413 persons who received the sum of \$3,760,667 in salaries and wages. The materials supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc. amounted to \$241,278.

There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of women's and children's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$2,926,379 or 54 per cent of total. They accounted for 52 per cent of the employees and 58 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.
