SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1955

This first section of the report presents the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by this report, namely; the women's factory clothing industry, the children's factory clothing industry, and the women's and children's clothing contractors industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of the firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of the sections.

The value of products shipped from the factories of women's and children's clothing manufacturers in 1955 was \$276,195,482, an increase of \$13,155,657 or 5 per cent over the preceding year \$263,039,825. The absolute increase was higher in the case of the women's industry (\$7,732,721) than is the children's industry (\$5,422,936) but percentagewise it amounted to only 3.5 per cent in the former compared with 12.2 per cent in the latter. Employment for the two industries combined was down slightly to 33,990 in 1955 from 34,103 in 1954, an increase in the children's industry being offset by a decrease in the women's. Salary and wage payments however, rose to \$74,795,983 in the later year from \$73,567,439 in the earlier. Material costs were also higher, being \$149,606,020 in 1955 as against \$139,973,164 in 1954.

In 1955 there were 930 establishments in the two industries distributed provincially as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 592, Ontario 268, Manitoba 35, Saskatchewan 3, Alberta 6 and British Columbia 23. There is heavy concentration in Montreal and Toronto, the two cities together accounting for 80 per cent of employment and 83 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant with 20,908 employees and shipments valued at \$180,749,072, 62 and 65 per cent respectively, while Toronto accounted for 6,386 employees and shipments of \$49,758,348, 19 and 18 per cent respectively. The standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of factory shipments, by sections, is given in the table at the top of the page following.

The women's and children's factory clothing industries are divided along commodity lines into

six divisions the principal statistics of which are compiled in Table 2. Increases over 1954 in the value of goods shipped was reported by all but two. The value of factory shipments in 1955 for the six divisions, with 1954 figures in brackets, are as follows: women's dresses \$80,160,120 (\$77,232,517), women's coats and suits \$52,711,722 (\$53,318,854), children's clothing \$49,848,404 (\$44,425,468); skirts, blouses and jackets, \$40,916,254 (\$37,090,518); lingerie, \$33,726,967 (\$32,419,781); other outerwear, \$18,832,015 (\$18,552,687). The largest increase, both absolutely and percentagewise, was enjoyed by the children's clothing section where a 12.2 per cent rise occurred. This section also recorded the largest increase in employment. Declines in the number of employed were reported by three of the six divisions.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses of which 6,150,744 valued at \$43,584,641 were shipped. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were the following women's and misses' garments: wool coats, 1,473,330 valued at \$34,086,240; cotton dresses, fine, 2,661,215 at \$14,091,589; wool suits, 440,688 at \$10,833,941 and wool skirts, 1,495,163 at \$8,925,602. Children's wool coats followed with shipments of 874,231 worth \$8,411,661. Further detail of shipments is available from Table 3.

Imports of clothing and furnishings rose from \$57,118,733 in 1954 to \$60,155,878 in 1955. Exports increased from \$1,329,129 to \$1,590,108 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

Note on 1956—While the Census of Industry survey for 1956 has only nicely gotten underway, data from other sources in the Bureau indicate a slight increase in activity in the two industries under review. based on a monthly sample survey, the value of factory shipments for the industries combined is estimated to have been 3.3 per cent higher than in 1955. Man-hours worked were greater by 3.9 per cent according to a monthly survey of all firms with 15 or more employees. Associated with this expanded activity at factory level was an estimated 7.2 per cent increase in 1956 in retail sales of women's and children's clothing.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1955

Factory shipments made by the women's factory clothing industry in 1955 had a value f.o.b. plant of \$226,347,078. This was an increase of \$7,732,721 or 3.5 per cent over the \$218,614,357 worth of goods shipped in 1954. Employment on the other, was down by 1.5 per cent from 27,343 to 26,925. The salary and wage bill was practically the same in the two years being \$61,448,428 in the former and \$61,455,380 in the latter. The cost of materials consumed in manufacture rose by 5.1 per cent from \$115,988,150 in 1954 to \$121,858,177 in 1955. There were 58 fewer establishments in the year under review.

The industry in 1955 was comprised of 750 establishments distributed as follows: New Brunswick 3, Quebec 465, Ontario 223, Manitoba 27, Saskatchewan 3, Alberta 6 and British Columbia 23. The location of 440 and 203 establishments respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration of the industry in the two cities. Montreal accounted for 62 per cent of the employment and 65 per cent of the value of factory shipments.

The women's factory clothing industry is made up of establishments of varying sizes. In 1955 a group of 38 establishments, each reporting shipments in excess of \$1,000,000, accounted for \$52,391,222 or 23 per cent of the industry's total shipments. Of the 750 establishments in the industry, 385 shipped goods valued between \$100,000 and \$500,000. From Table 16 it will be seen that there is no marked degree of concentration of output in any one size group.

Five more or less distinct sections comprise the women's factory clothing industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 11 with Table 12 showing a breakdown by cities. The "dresses" section is considerably larger than any of the others and in the year under review made shipments valued at \$80,160,120 or 35 per cent of the total. Montreal, the centre of the dress industry, reported \$64,271,215 or 80 per cent of this amount. The "coats and suits" section ranked second in value of shipments with \$52,711,722 followed by "skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets" with \$40,916,254, "lingerie" with \$33,726,967 and "other outerwear" with \$18,832,015.

Table 13A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made in the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 21A shows a like situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish detail in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports on the other hand represent a sizable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, in Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1955

The Bureau began compiling separate statistics on the children's factory clothing industry in 1937. The history of the industry since that time has been one of continuous growth represented by an unbroken series of annual increments to value of production and, excluding 1941, of yearly increases in employment. The first break in this uptrending activity came in 1954 when the number of employees, salary and wage payments, cost of materials and value of factory shipments were all lower than in 1953. The reductions were, however, of small proportions and the level of operations for the year under review was the second highest on record. In 1955 the uptrend was resumed with employment and output at all-time highs.

Factory selling value of products shipped by the industry reached \$49,848,404. This total represents an increase of 9.9 per cent over the previous high of \$45,347,640 established in 1953 and an increase of 12.2 per cent over the \$44,425,468 worth of goods shipped in 1954. Employees numbered a record 7,065, a figure exceeding the former record of 6,893 in 1953 by 2.5 per cent and 1954's 6,760 by 4.5 per cent. Salary and wage payments of \$13,340,603 and material costs of \$27,747,843 were also the highest ever.

There were 180 establishments in 1955, 9 more than the year before. They were confined to Quebec,

Ontario and Manitoba with these provinces having 127, 45 and 8, respectively. The industry is largely concentrated in three cities. Montreal with 105 establishments shipped goods with a value of \$32,612,127 or 65 per cent of the total for the industry. Toronto accounted for \$5,713,330 or 11 per cent and Winnipeg for \$2,294,959 or 5 per cent.

Table 21A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made in the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 13A shows a like situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish details in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS' 1955

This industry in 1955 was comprised of 116 establishments of which 100 were in Quebec, 15 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these contractors was \$5,777,900 or 6.9 per cent higher than the \$5,406,735 reported in 1954. Employment was provided for 2,539 persons who received the sum of \$4,070,792 in salaries and wages. The materials, supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$247,383.

There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of women's and children's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$2,968,005 or 51 per cent of total. They accounted for 49 per cent of the employees and 56 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.
