NOTICE

SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1957

This first section of the report presents the overall statistics for the combined women's and children's factory clothing industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by this report, namely; the women's factory clothing industry, the children's factory clothing industry, and the women's and children's clothing contractors industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of the firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of the sections.

The value of products shipped from the factories of women's and children's clothing manufacturers in 1957 was \$306,534,252, an increase of \$11,278,477 or 3.8 per cent over the preceding year's \$295,255,775. The absolute increase was higher in the case of the women's industry (\$7,783,190) than in the children's industry (\$3,495,287); but, percentagewise, it amounted to only 3.3 per cent in the former compared with 6.1 per cent in the latter. Employment for the two industries combined was up slightly to 33,802 in 1957 from 33,351 in 1956, both industries showing an increase. Salary and wage payments rose to \$82,677,484 in the later year from \$77,712,591 in the former, an increase of 6.4 per cent. Material costs were also higher, being \$167,342,231 in 1957 as against \$164,890,662 in 1956.

In 1957 there were 858 establishments in the two industries distributed provincially as follows: New Brunswick 2, Quebec 563, Ontario 233, Manitoba 32, Saskatchewan 2, Alberta 7 and British Columbia 19. There is a heavy concentration in Montreal and Toronto, the two cities together accounting for 81 per cent of employment and 84 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant with 21,001 employees and shipments valued at \$203,459,622, 62 and 68 per cent respectively, while Toronto accounted for 6,444 employees and shipments of \$55,114,476, 19 and 18 per cent respectively. The standing of the two cities as regards the number of employees and value of factory shipments, by sections, is given in the table at the top of the following page.

The women's and children's factory clothing industries are divided along commodity lines into six divisions, the principal statistics of which are presented in Table 2. Increases over 1956 in the

value of goods shipped were reported by all of them. The value of factory shipments in 1957 for the six divisions, with 1955 figures in brackets are as follows: women's dresses \$85,637,846 (\$83,931,003); children's clothing, \$61,139,624 (\$57,644,337); women's coats and suits, \$55,998,019 (\$54,189,231); skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets \$46,631,387 (43,399,720); lingerie, \$36,848,534 (\$35,919,711); and, other outerwear, \$20,278,842 (\$20,171,773). The largest percentagewise increase occurred in the skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets section where a 7.4 per cent increase was recorded. This section also recorded the largest increase in employment. The largest absolute volume gain was in the children's clothing section where an increase of \$3,495,287 took place. Declines in the number of employed were reported by four of the six divisions.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses of which 4,915,661 valued at \$41,583,909 were shipped. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were the following: women's and misses' garments: wool coats, 1,371,524 valued at \$34,497,466; cotton dresses, fine, 3,055,833 at \$18,688,490; wool skirts, 2,052,189 at \$13,065,515; and, wool suits, 352,143 at \$10,599,687. Children's wool coats followed with shipments of 906,905 worth \$8,790,866. Further details of shipments is available from Table 3.

Imports of clothing and furnishings increased from \$57,975,459 in 1956 to \$59,668,053 in 1957. On the other hand, exports decreased from \$1,759,880 to \$1,479,049 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports, reference should be made to Tables 4 and 5.

Note on 1958 — While the Census of Industry survey for 1958 is still quite incomplete, data from other sources in the Bureau indicate some changes in the two industries under review. Based on a monthly sample survey, the value of factory shipments for the combined industries is estimated to have been 2 per cent lower than in 1957. Man-hours worked were greater by almost 4 per cent according to a monthly survey of all firms with 15 or more employees. Associated with this expanded activity at the factory level was an estimated increase of almost 4 per cent in the retail sales of women's and children's clothing during 1957.

¹ Commencing with 1952 the gross value of production was replaced by value of factory shipments.² Principal Statistics for 1949 and later are not comparable with earlier years due to adoption of the Standard Industrial Classification in 1949.³ Because of insufficient inventory data in 1952 and 1953, these figures have been calculated from value of factory shipments and are, therefore, only approximations to true "Value added by manufacturer."

Note: Profits and losses cannot be estimated from Census figures as no data are collected for certain expense items such as interest, rent, depreciation, taxes, insurance, advertising, etc.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1957

Factory shipments made by the women's factory clothing industry in 1957 had a f.o.b. plant value of \$245,394,628. This was an increase of \$7,783,190 or 3.3 per cent over the \$237,611,438 worth of goods shipped in 1956. Employment was also up by 1.4 per cent from 25,821 to 26,192. Salary and wages increased by 5.0 per cent from \$63,223,780 in 1956 to \$66,393,053 in the year under review. Cost of materials consumed in manufacture decreased very slightly by 0.5 per cent from \$132,860,064 in 1956 to \$132,232,239 in 1957. There were 13 fewer establishments in the year under review.

This industry in 1957 was comprised of 670 establishments distributed as follows: New Brunswick 2, Quebec 425, Ontario 191, Manitoba 25, Saskatchewan 2, Alberta 7 and British Columbia 18. The location of 401 and 171 establishments respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration of the industry in the two cities. Montreal accounted for 63 per cent of the employment and 67 per cent of the value of factory shipments.

The women's factory clothing industry is made up of establishments of varying sizes. In 1957 a group of 46 establishments, each reporting shipments in excess of \$1,000,000, accounted for \$67,797,186 or 28 per cent of the industry's total shipments. Of the 670 establishments in the industry, 344 shipped goods valued between \$100,000 and \$500,000. From Table 17 it will be seen that there is no marked degree of concentration of output in any one size group.

Five more or less distinct sections comprise the women's factory clothing industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 12 with Table 13 showing a breakdown by cities. The "dresses" section is considerably larger than any of the others; and, in the year under review, made shipments valued at \$85,637,846 or 35 per cent of the total. Montreal, the centre of the dress industry, reported \$70,246,423 or 82 per cent of this amount. The "coats and suits" section ranked second in value of shipments with \$55,998,019; followed by "skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets" with \$46,631,387; "lingerie" with \$36,848,534; and "other outerwear" with \$20,278,842.

Table 14A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made in the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 22A shows a like situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish detail in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports, on the other hand, represent a sizable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, in Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1957

The Bureau began compiling separate statistics on the children's factory clothing industry in 1937. The history of this industry since that time has been one of continuous growth represented by an unbroken series of annual increments to value of production and, excluding 1941, of yearly increases in employment. The first break in this increasing activity came in 1954 when the number of employees, salary and wage payments, cost of materials and value of factory shipments were all lower than in 1953. The trend upwards was resumed in 1955, in 1956, and, now in 1957, successive all-time highs being established each year in both employment and output. The improvement in the year under review was, as shown in the following paragraph, quite substantial.

Factory selling value of products shipped by the industry reached \$61,139,624. This total represents an increase of 6.1 per cent over the \$57,644,337 worth of goods shipped in 1956. Employees numbered 7,610; a figure exceeding the former record of 7,530 in 1956 by 1.1 per cent. Salary and wage payments of \$16,284,431 and material costs of \$35,109,992 were also the highest ever.

There were 188 establishments in 1957, three less than the year before. These were confined to

Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba and British Columbia with these provinces having 138, 42, 7 and 1, respectively. This industry is largely concentrated in three cities. Montreal, with 115 establishments, shipped goods with a value of \$39,215,420 or 64 per cent of the total for the industry. Toronto accounted for \$8,063,564 or 13 per cent; and Winnipeg for \$2,643,057 or 4 per cent.

Table 22A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made in the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be seen that the quantity and value for a number of classifications cannot be given because there are too few producers. Reference to Table 14A shows a like situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been possible to publish details in a good many more instances. The combined statistics will be found in Table 3A on page 5.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's and children's clothing for which reason imports and exports of these are shown together in Section 1, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1957

This industry in 1957 was comprised of 143 establishments of which 125 were in Quebec, 17 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these contractors was \$8,416,634 or 30.4 per cent higher than the \$6,454,292 reported in 1956. Employment was provided for 3,446 persons who received the sum of \$5,765,143 in salaries and wages, increases of 31.5 per cent and of 33.4 per cent, respectively, over the previous year. The materials, supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of threads, buttons, etc.,

amounted to \$643,902, an increase of 42.8 per cent over 1956.

There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of women's and children's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$4,485,679 or 53 per cent of the total. They accounted for 47 per cent of the employees and for 58 per cent of the salary and wage payments of the industry.
