EXPLANATORY NOTES

This report is one in a series of about 130 publications which present the results of the 1958 Census of Manufactures. Most reports in this series refer to specific industries, but there are summary reports for Canada and the provinces and for major industry groups. An annual Census of Manufactures has been carried out by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics since 1916.

Industry statistics given in these reports refer to number of establishments, employees, salaries and wages, cost of materials, supplies, fuel and electricity, gross value of shipments, inventories and value added by manufacturing. Details of materials used and products shipped are also given. Descriptions of the principal industry statistics, with special reference to 1958, are as follows:

Period Covered

Firms are asked to submit figures for the calendar year, if at all possible, and most reports are on this basis. Financial year reports for periods differing from the calendar year are accepted in instances where the firms find it impossible to supply calendar year data from accounting records. However the data on employees, salaries and wages are requested on a calendar year basis in all cases.

Establishment

Data for the annual census is collected on an establishment basis. A firm with more than one plant is required to file a report for each plant. In most cases an establishment is a complete factory. Sometimes, however, a plant is divided into two or more establishments when it carries out operations classifiable to different industries and when separate accounting records are available. Usually the statistics for an establishment relate only to the manufacturing activities. Other activities such as construction at the plant by its own employees, wholesale or retail activities carried on at the plant location, etc., are not included. Plants engaged solely in repair work (except in the case of furniture, shipbuilding, boat building, aircraft and railway rolling stock industries) are not included but plants occupied in assembling parts into complete units are included.

Employees

Administrative and office employees include all executives and supervisory officials such as presidents, vice-presidents, secretaries, treasurers, etc., together with managers, professional and technical employees, superintendents and factory supervisors above the working foremen level and clerical employees. Working owners and partners are also included in this category.

Production and related workers include all other factory workmen whether paid on a monthly, weekly, hourly or piece-work basis. Working foremen doing work similar to that of the employees they supervise are included, as are maintenance, warehousing and delivery staffs. Employees on new construction work, in retail or wholesale operations, on outside piece work etc., are not included.

Production workers are reported by months, an average for the year being obtained by summing the monthly figures and dividing by twelve. This procedure is followed even though the plant did not operate in all months. Figures on employment refer to calendar years whether or not some establishments reported other data on a financial year basis.

Salaries and Wages

Salaries and wages refer to gross earnings of the employees described above, including salaries, wages, commissions, bonuses, the value of room and board where provided, deductions for income tax and social services such as sickness and unemployment insurance, pensions, etc., as well as any other allowances forming part of the employees' wages. Payments for overtime are included.

Salaries refer to amounts paid to administrative and office employees. Withdrawals by working owners or partners for normal living expenses for self and family are included but not their withdrawals for income tax. Wages refer to the amounts paid to production and related workers as defined above. Data on earnings refer to the calendar year whether or not some establishments reported other data on a financial year basis.

Cost of Fuel and Electricity

Figures for fuel refer to amounts actually used, (including fuel used in cars and trucks), not to purchases unless the quantities are the same. Values refer to the laid-down cost at the works, including freight, duty, etc.

Materials and Supplies Used

Figures represent quantities and laid-down cost values, at the works, of materials and supplies actually used during the year whether purchased from others or received as transfers from other plants of the reporting company. Amounts paid to other manufacturers for work done on materials owned by the reporting company are included. Returnable containers or any other items charged to capital account are not included. Fuels are not included. Goods bought from others or received as transfers from other plants of reporting companies

for resale without further processing are not included. Maintenance and repair supplies not chargeable to capital account are included.

Factory Shipments

Factory shipments refer to shipments of goods made from own materials either in the reporting plant or by other manufacturers on the basis of a charge to the reporting plant for work done. All products and by-products shipped from the establishment are included whether for domestic use, export, or for government departments. Transfer shipments to sales outlets, distributing warehouses or to other manufacturing units of the reporting firm are included. Goods bought or received as transfers and resold without further processing are not included. Values are computed on f.o.b. plant or plant warehouse basis, and do not include sales tax or excise duties. Values of containers not returnable are included. Amounts received in payment for work done on materials owned by others are included.

In a few industries such as shipbuilding, aircraft, etc., where work on principal products extend over a relatively long period, the value of production is recorded rather than the value of shipments. For those industries production is computed from the value of deliveries of complete units during the year plus the value of work done during the year on unfinished units less the value of work done in previous years on finished units delivered in the year under review.

Inventories

Values represent the book values of manufacturing inventories owned and held at the reporting plant. Figures include inventories held in warehouses or selling outlets which have been included with plant operations for purposes of reporting shipments.

Value Added by Manufacturing

Figures are computed from value of shipments plus or minus changes in inventories of finished

goods and goods in process less cost of materials, fuel and electricity. This figure is sometimes referred to as net production.¹

Standard Industrial Classification

The Standard Industrial Classification Manual, prepared by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, provides for 135 three-digit industries in the manufacturing sector, arranged in 17 major groups. Reporting establishments are classified or allotted to specific industries on the basis of the value of principal products made or shipped.

Short Forms

Prior to 1949 all manufacturing firms, regardless of size, were required to complete a standard form annually covering all census details, but for later years an effort was made to ease the reporting burden for smaller firms which usually do not maintain regular records in the required detail. A modified or short form was introduced in 1949 asking for the total value of shipments only, or in industries with a large number of small firms, for total value of shipments and quantities and values of a few principal products. Using the ratio of value of shipments in the current year to value of shipments in the base year, 1948, estimates of other census data were made for each plant for inclusion in the regular compilations. In general, the cut-off point for short forms was set at \$50,000 gross value of shipments annually, but there were lower cut-offs for a number of industries in which the small firms accounted for a larger share of total shipments. About 40 per cent of the total number of establishments reported on the modified or short form. They accounted for less than 3 per cent of the total value. In 1958, to establish a new base year, the small firms were again asked to report data on employees, salaries and wages, and other principal statistics together with some detail on material and products.

¹ To arrive at the National Accounts concept of "gross domestic product at factor cost", it would be necessary to subtract also the cost of office supplies used, advertising, insurance and other goods and services obtained from other businesses. Data on these inputs are not collected on the annual Census of Manufactures. Value added figures for "The primary industries and construction" are published in D.B.S. publication 61-202, *Survey of Production*.

SECTION I. THE COMBINED WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRIES, 1958

The first section of this report presents the overall statistics for the combined Women's and Children's Factory Clothing Industries. The three other sections which follow deal separately with the industries covered by the report: II. The Women's Factory Clothing Industry; III. The Children's Factory Clothing Industry; and IV. The Women's and Children's Clothing Contractors Industry. The developments within these industries are noted in their respective sections and a list of firms reporting to each industry follows at the end of each section.

The value of products shipped from the factories of the women's and children's clothing manufacturers in 1958 was \$315,951,243, an increase of \$9,416,991, or 3.1 per cent over the preceding year's \$306,534,252. The absolute gain was greater in the case of the Women's Industry (\$5,062,795) than in the Children's Industry (\$4,354,196); but in terms of percentage the increases were 2.1 per cent in the former and 7.1 per cent in the latter. Employment for the combined industries was down slightly, from 33,802 in 1957 to 33,542 in 1958. However, salary and wage payments rose by \$2,773,059, or 3.4 per cent, to \$85,450,543 in the latter year from \$82,677,484 in the former. Material costs also were higher, being \$169,149,542 in 1958 compared to \$167,342,231 in 1957, an increase of 1.1 per cent.

In the two industries in 1958 there were 846 establishments, 12 fewer than in 1957, distributed as follows: Nova Scotia 1; New Brunswick 1; Quebec 559; Ontario 223; Manitoba 31; Saskatchewan 2; Alberta 8; and British Columbia 21. The heaviest concentrations of plants were in Montreal and Toronto with the two cities accounting for 82.0 per cent of employment and 84.0 per cent of the value of factory shipments. Montreal was preponderant in both fields, with 21,175 employees and shipments valued at \$208,977,193, or 63.1 and 66.1 per cent, respectively. Toronto accounted for 6,336 employees and \$56,443,563 worth of shipments, 18.9 and 17.9 per cent, respectively. The standing of the two cities with regard to the number of persons employed and the value of factory sales, by sections, is given in the table at the top of the following page.

The Women's and Children's Factory Clothing Industries are divided along commodity lines into six divisions, the principal statistics for which

are presented in Table 2. Increases over 1957 in the value of goods shipped were reported by all but one, namely the women's coats and suits section. The value of factory shipments in 1958 for the six divisions, with the comparable 1957 figures in brackets, were: women's dresses \$86,118,766 (\$85,637,846); children's clothing \$65,493,820 (\$61,139,624); women's coats and suits \$54,382,035 (\$55,998,019); skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets \$48,972,820 (\$46,631,387); lingerie \$40,129,788 (\$36,848,534); and other outerwear \$20,854,014 (\$20,278,842). The biggest absolute increase, \$4,254,196, occurred in the children's clothing division, whilst the largest proportional gain, 8.9 per cent, was reported in the lingerie section. The decrease in shipments of women's coats and suits amounted to \$1,615,984, or 2.9 per cent.

The most important single commodity proved to be women's and misses' wool coats, of which 2,173,880 valued at \$41,357,757 were shipped in 1958. The previous year's leader, women's and misses' rayon and rayon mixture dresses, was in second place with sales of 5,016,505 garments worth \$40,687,180. For further details of factory shipments see Table 3.

Imports of clothing and furnishings increased by 10.3 per cent, from \$30,290,908 in 1957 (revised) to \$33,415,285 in 1958. On the other hand, exports fell over the same two-year period, from \$1,479,049 to \$1,378,696. For full details of imports and exports see Tables 4 and 5.

Table 8 gives details of power installations for this industry for 1958, representing the results of a special survey made every five years.

Note on 1959.—While the Census of Industry Survey for 1959 is still quite incomplete, data from other sources in the Bureau indicate no change at the manufacturing level. Based on a monthly sample survey, the value of factory shipments for the combined industries is estimated to have been the same as in 1958. On the other hand, there was an estimated increase of almost 5 per cent in the retail sales of women's and children's clothing during 1959.

¹ Commencing with 1952 the gross value of production was replaced by value of factory shipments.² Principal Statistics for 1949 and later are not comparable with earlier years due to adoption of the Standard Industrial Classification in 1949.³ Because of insufficient inventory data in 1952 and 1953, these figures have been calculated from value of factory shipments and are, therefore, only approximations to true "Value added by manufacture."

Note: Profits and losses cannot be estimated from Census figures as no data are collected for certain expense items such as interest, rent, depreciation, taxes, insurance, advertising, etc.

SECTION II. THE WOMEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1958

In 1958 The Women's Factory Clothing Industry made shipments amounting to \$250,457,423 f.o.b. plant, \$5,062,795 or 2.1 per cent higher than the \$245,394,628 worth of goods shipped in 1957. Employment was lower by 2.0 per cent, from 26,192 in 1957, to 25,676, but total salary and wage payments of \$68,469,880 in 1958 were \$2,076,827, or 3.1 per cent higher than the previous year's payroll of \$66,393,053. The cost of materials used in manufacture increased by less than one per cent, from \$132,232,239 in 1957 to \$132,488,602 in 1958.

This industry in 1958 consisted of 660 establishments (670 in 1957) and they were distributed thusly; Nova Scotia 1; New Brunswick 1; Quebec 416; Ontario 187; Manitoba 25; Saskatchewan 2; Alberta 8; and British Columbia 20. The location of 394 and 164 plants respectively in Montreal and Toronto indicates the extent of concentration in those two cities. Montreal itself accounted for 62.7 per cent of the employment and for 66.2 per cent of the total value of factory shipments.

The industry is comprised of five more or less distinct sections, and the value of factory shipments from each of these sections in 1958 was: dresses \$86,118,766; coats and suits \$54,382,035; skirts, blouses, slacks and jackets \$48,972,820; lingerie \$40,129,788; and other outerwear \$20,854,014. From

the foregoing it may readily be seen that the "dresses" section is much the largest with shipments amounting to 34.4 per cent of the grand total. Montreal, the centre of Canada's dress industry, reported sales of \$71,271,058, or 82.8 per cent of the total shipments of dresses.

Table 15A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of children's garments are made by the women's factory clothing industry. It will also be noted that statistics for a number of classifications cannot be given separately, because there are too few producers. There is a similar situation for women's garments in the children's factory clothing industry (see Table 23A). By combining the data of the two industries it has been found possible to publish detail in many more instances. These combined statistics are to be found in Table 3A.

Exports of women's clothing are not large in relation to the domestic market. Imports, on the other hand, represent a sizeable share of this market. Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's from children's clothing. For this reason imports and exports of these two commodities are shown together in Section I, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION III. THE CHILDREN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY, 1958

Once again, as it has in every year since 1954, The Children's Factory Clothing Industry in 1958 established a new record high in both employment and output. Factory shipments during the year attained a total value of \$65,493,820, which was 7.1 per cent above the previous high of \$61,139,624 reported in 1957. Employment was up by 3.4 per cent, from 7,610 in 1957 to 7,866 in 1958. Salary and wage payments, at \$16,980,663, were 4.3 per cent above the preceding year's \$16,284,431. The cost of materials used was also the highest ever, being up by 4.4 per cent from \$35,109,992 in 1957 to \$36,660,940 in the year under review.

There were 186 establishments reporting in 1958, two less than the year before. These were confined to Quebec, with 143; Ontario, with 36; Manitoba, 6; and British Columbia, 1. This industry was mainly concentrated in three cities. Montreal, with 116 establishments, shipped goods with a value of \$43,087,602, or 65.8 per cent of the total for the

industry; Toronto accounted for \$8,589,458, or 13.1 per cent; and Winnipeg for \$2,518,263, or 3.8 per cent.

Table 23A gives, in as much detail as is possible and permissible, information on the industry's commodities. It will be seen that substantial quantities of women's garments are made by the children's factory clothing industry. It will also be noted that statistics for a number of classifications cannot be given separately, because there are too few producers. There is a similar situation for children's garments in the women's factory clothing industry. By combining the data of the two industries it has been found possible to publish details in many more instances. These combined statistics are given in Table 3A.

Canadian trade classifications do not generally separate women's from children's clothing. For this reason, imports and exports of the two commodities are shown together in Section I, Tables 4 and 5.

SECTION IV. WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1958

This industry in 1958 consisted of 145 establishments of which 132 were in Quebec, 12 in Ontario and 1 in Manitoba. The gross value of the work performed by these clothing contractors, at \$8,785,665, was 4.4 per cent higher than the comparable 1957 figure of \$8,416,634. Employment was provided for 3,698 persons, 252 or 7.3 per cent more than the 3,446 reported in 1957. Salary and wage payments in 1958 of \$6,314,947 were 9.5 per cent higher than the previous year's \$5,765,143. The cost of materials, supplied by the contractors themselves and consisting principally of thread, buttons,

etc., amounted to \$714,018, an increase of 10.9 per cent over the \$643,902 spent in 1957.

There is, naturally, a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the majority of women's and children's clothing firms are to be found. The value of the work performed by the contractors of this city totalled \$4,977,926, or 56.7 per cent of the total. They also accounted for 50.3 per cent of all employees, and for 57.1 per cent of the salary and wage payments within the industry.


