## IEN'S EUKNISHING GOODS INDUSTRY IN CANAIA, 1225.

Ottawa, liarch, 1927.- A report is herewith presented on the Men's Furnishing Goods Industry in Canada during the calendar year 1925. There was a slight increase over the previous year in the number of establishnents in operation. The nurber repcrted for 1925 being 135 located by provinces as follows:- Ontario 52, Quebec 62, Manitoba 9, British Colunbia 8, Alberta 2, Nova Scotia 2. In order not to disclose information concerning the operaticns of individual establishments, statistics for the last two provinces have been combined and are shown throughout this report as "Other provinces".

CAPITAL INVESTAMTT
The total capital employed in tho industra during the calendar yomr 1925 is given by provincos in Tablo III. The total capitalization foll from $\$ 17,162,883$ in 1924 to $\$ 16,650,582$ in 1925, a decreas of $\$ 512,301$. The province of Queboc provided the largest contribution to the total capital investmont rith $\$ 8,158,084$, or 48.6 por cont whilst Ontario supglied $\$ 6,196,725$ or 37.2 por cont.

## EMPLOYEES, SALARIES AND WAGES

The total number of pursons omployed in the industry during the calendar year 1925 vill be found by provinces in Tablo IV by (a) classes of employment (b) sex and (6) salary and vage payments. The total number of employees in all classes rose from 6,885 in 1924 to 7,294 in 1925, an increase of 409 . In 1924 the salary and wage paynents totalled $\$ 5,031,596$ whilst for 1925 the amount reported was $\$ 5,222,924$, an increase of $\$ 191,328$ over the tro year period.

## VATERIALS USED

The total cost of all materials used in the industry rose from $\$ 12,511,336$ in 1924 to $\$ 13,126,738$ in 1925, an increase of $\$ 615,402$. With a view to molifying the industrial questionnaire mamafaturers of men's furnishing goods mere not required to furnish information relating to either the kind or quantity of the various materials used in the industry during tho year 2925. By provinces Ontario leads with a total expenditure of $\$ 5,387: 550$, follomed by Quebec witr $\$ 5,270,424$. Vanitoba cocupies third place oith $\$ 1,386,485$ mbilst British Columbia in fourth position accounted for $\$ 273,812$, the balance $\$ 708,467$ being accounted for by the remaining two provinces.

## gUEL STATISTICS

The quantity and value of the varicus kinds of fuel used in tre industry during the calendar year 1925 is shown in Table VI. The total cost of all fuel declined from $\$ 3,157$ in 1924 tc $\$ 76,131$ in 1925 , a decrease of $\$ 3,025$. Cosl of all kinds was again the princinal item, accounting for $\$ 65,982$ or 86.5 per cent of the total experditure for fuel whilst mool and gas follow next in importance in the order named.

## POTHS IMSTMLTATIOA

The nower installation of the indastry for the calondar yoar 1925 will be found in Table VII by (a) classes of power, (b) momber of units in each class and (c) the horse power capacity accoring to manufacturers' rating. There mas a small increase in the number of units, viz., 429 in 1925 as against 410 in 1924 . On the other hand the horse power utilized was slightly less than in the previous year being 2,650 in 1925 and $:, 765$ in 1924 .

## IMPORTS AND EXPORTS

The quantity and value of the various articles comprising this industry froported ints Canaua for consumption during the calendar year 1925 is given in Table VIII by principal countries of origin. Only one item classified under the head of men's furnishing goods was exported from Canada during the same period, viz. "Suspenders", the values being to United Kinedom $\$ 6,069$ and to other countries $\$ 45,173$.
