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THE MEN'S FURNISHING GOODS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1937.

In 1937 reports were received from 195 establishments whose principal output was men's and boys' furnishings, being an increase of nineteen over the number reporting during 1936.

This industry has shown appreciable improvement during the year under review. The gross value of production increased by \$2,136,061 or more than 8 per cent over the production of 1936, while the capital invested also increased by \$1,096,136 or over 6 per cent. During the year the number of persons given employment increased by 663 or over 7 per cent, and their total remuneration was \$809,334 or 13 per cent greater than in 1936. There was also an increase in the cost of materials used which advanced by \$1,309,676 or more than 8 per cent.

The distribution of the 195 establishments reporting in 1937 was as follows: - Nova Scotia, one, New Brunswick, two, Quebec, eighty-six, Ontario, seventy-one, Manitoba, eighteen, Alberta, three, and British Columbia, fourteen.

The principal item of production in this industry in 1937 was men's and boys' shirts to the value of \$9,460,429 of which \$6,696,485 represented the factory value of fine shirts and \$2,763,944 the value of work shirts. Next in importance was overalls to the value of \$3,940,697, followed by neckties, \$2,350,338 working pants \$1,809,860 and pyjamas at \$1,215,071. Further detailed information on production is given in Table 4.

The imports of furnishings during 1937 amounted to \$1,470,648 or \$151,447 higher than in the previous year. Handkerchiefs to the value of \$1,379,315 were the chief item of import.

Exports in this industry were very small, and in 1937 consisted mainly of braces and suspenders to the value of \$8,999.

The group in which an establishment is classified is determined by its main products. For example, a firm producing \$1,000 worth of neckwear and \$500 worth of suspenders would be classified in the "neckwear" section, whereas a firm manufacturing the following products, shirts \$200,000, overalls \$50,000 and neckwear \$40,000 would be classified in the "men's and boys' shirts" section.
