

Returns from 1,056 sawmill operators were compiled for December, these mills accounting for 61.37 per cent of the total output east of the Rockies in 1954. From these returns, preliminary estimates for all mills in the provinces covered have been prepared.

According to these calculations, the production of sawn lumber, east of the Rockies (excluding sawn ties) amounted to 131,306 M ft. b.m. in December, as compared with 129,453 M ft. the previous month and with 171,515 M ft. in December 1955.

Table 1 gives a comparative summary of the production of reporting operators, the estimated production of all operators, and shipments and stocks on hand of reporting operators. This table shows the reported production in December registered a decrease of 2.58 per cent from the previous month and a decrease of 22.96 per cent from December 1955, while estimated production of all operators increased 1.43 per cent over November 1956 but decreased 23.44 per cent from December 1955. Shipments of reporting operators totalled 98,363 M ft. in December 1956 as compared with 123,619 M ft. in November 1956, a decrease of 20.43 per cent and reported stocks on hand at the end of December 1956 amounted to 431,639 as compared with 447,897 M ft. on the last day of November 1956, a decrease of 3.63 per cent.

Les rapports de 1,056 exploitants ont été colligés pour décembre dont les moulins ont contribué 61.37 p. 100 de la production à l'est des Rocheuses en 1954. Grâce à ces rapports, on a pu faire des estimations préliminaires pour toutes les scieries de ces provinces.

D'après ces calculs, la production de bois d'œuvre à l'est des Rocheuses (traverses sciées exclues) aurait atteint 131,306 M p.m.p. en décembre comparativement à 129,453 M p.m.p. le mois précédent et 171,515 M p.m.p. en décembre 1955.

Le tableau 1 donne un résumé comparé de la production des exploitants qui font rapport, de la production estimative de tous les exploitants, et des expéditions et des stocks des exploitants, qui font rapport. Ce tableau fait voir que la production déclarée en décembre diminue de 2.58 p. 100 comparativement au mois précédent et diminue de 22.96 p. 100 comparativement à décembre 1955. Par ailleurs la production estimative de tous les exploitants augmente de 1.43 p. 100 comparativement à novembre de 1956 mais diminue de 23.44 p. 100 comparativement à décembre de 1955. Les expéditions des exploitants qui font rapport s'établissent au total, à 98,363 M p. au regard de 123,619 M p. en novembre 1956 diminution de 20.43. Les stocks en mains déclarés à la fin de décembre 1956 sont de 431,639 M p. comparativement à 447,897 M p. le dernier jour de novembre 1956 diminution de 3.63 p. 100.

Tables 2 to 5 give the production, shipments and stocks on hand of the mills reporting only. It is to be noted that all these figures may cover different mills from month to month and also that quantities for shipments and stocks on hand sometimes include lumber purchased for resale by certain mills.

The 288 mills which reported sawing in December produced 69,710 M ft. of softwoods and 8,075 M ft. of hardwoods. This compared with 334 mills reporting the production of 69,460 M ft. of softwoods and 10,386 M ft. of hardwoods in November. Details by provinces and species are given in Table 2.

Shipments during December were reported by 433 operators, as compared with 468 in November. Particulars of shipments are given in Table 3. It is to be noted, however, that the first destination only is given and that some of the lumber shipped to wholesalers and exporters will eventually be reshipped to other provinces or exported. Similarly, much of the lumber shipped to wholesalers and retailers will eventually be used by building contractors, manufacturers and others.

Table 4 gives details of sawmill lumber stocks by provinces and by species, separating lumber sold but not shipped and lumber unsold. Stocks by species are further separated by grades, and unsold stocks are classified by thicknesses. Stocks at the end of December reported by 286 mills amounted to 431,639 M ft. of which 278,909 M ft. were sold and 152,730 M ft. unsold.

Table 5 shows the number of operators reporting, by provinces, and also the percentage of the sample to the 1954 production of all mills in the provinces covered.

NOTE: Tables 1 to 5 of this survey deal with production in all provinces east of the Rockies (except Newfoundland), shipments from sawmills in those provinces to the various domestic and foreign markets and to the various classes of customers, and stocks of sawn lumber on hand in sawmill yards at the end of the month. This survey is restricted to mills having an annual output of 500,000 or more feet board measure except in Prince Edward Island where it also includes mills in the 200 to 499 M ft. class. Sawmills in the 500,000 feet and over class accounted for 81.95 per cent of the total production of sawn lumber in 1954, in the eight provinces covered.

Les tableaux 2 à 5 donnent la production, les expéditions et les stocks des seules scieries qui font rapport. Il faut remarquer que tous ces chiffres peuvent s'appliquer parfois à des moulins différents d'un mois à l'autre et que les chiffres des expéditions et des stocks en mains comprennent parfois du bois acheté par certains moulins pour revente.

Les 288 moulins qui ont rapporté du sciage en décembre ont produit 69,710 M p. de bois tendre et 8,075 M p. de bois dur. Pour novembre, 334 scieries ont rapporté la production de 69,460 M p. de bois tendre et 10,386 M p. de bois dur. Les détails par province et par essence paraissent au tableau 2.

Les expéditions en décembre ont été déclarées par 433 exploitants, comparativement à 468 pour novembre, et paraissent en détail au tableau 3. A noter, cependant, que la première destination seulement est indiquée et qu'une partie du bois expédié aux grossistes et exportateurs sera éventuellement ré-expédiée à d'autres provinces ou exportée. De même une grande partie du bois expédié aux grossistes et aux détaillants sera ultimement utilisée par les entrepreneurs en construction, les manufacturiers et d'autres.

Les stocks de bois aux mains des scieries par province et par essence, paraissent en détail au tableau 4, distinction étant faite entre le bois vendu mais non expédié et le bois non vendu. Les stocks par essence sont de plus séparés selon la qualité et les stocks non vendus sont classifiés selon l'épaisseur. Les stocks déclarés à la fin de décembre par 286 moulins s'élèvent à 431,639 M p. dont 278,909 M p. vendus et 152,730 non vendus.

Le tableau 5 donne le nombre d'exploitants faisant rapport, par province et aussi le pourcentage de l'échantillon en fonction de la production de toutes les scieries dans les provinces concernées pour 1954.

NOTA: Les tableaux 1 à 5 de ce relevé portent sur la production de bois scié dans toutes les provinces à l'est des Rocheuses, (sauf Terre-Neuve), sur les expéditions des scieries de ces provinces aux divers marchés domestiques et étrangers et aux diverses catégories de clients, et sur les stocks de bois scié, en mains dans les cours des scieries à la fin du mois. Ce relevé est limité aux scieries dont la production annuelle est de 500,000 pieds ou plus, mesure de planche, sauf dans le cas de l'Île-du-Prince-Edouard où il comprend aussi les scieries produisant de 200 à 499 M p. Les scieries dont la production atteignait ou dépassait 500,000 pieds ont contribué en 1954, 81.95 pour cent de la production totale de bois scié dans les huit provinces en question.
