PRODUCTION, SHIPMENTS
AND STOCKS ON HAND OF SAWMILLS
EAST OF THE ROCKIES

FEBRUARY, 1952

Returns from 1,191 sawmill operators were compiled for February, these mills accounting for 63.31 per cent of the total output east of the Rockies in 1949. From these returns, preliminary estimates for all mills in the provinces covered have been prepared.

According to these calculations, the production of sawn lumber, east of the Rockies (excluding sawn ties) amounted to 232,874 M ft.b.m. in February, as compared with 176,313 M ft. the previous month and with 242,582 M ft. in February 1951.

Table 1 gives a comparative summary of the production of reporting operators, the estimated production of all operators, and shipments and stocks on hand of reporting operators. This Table shows the reported production in February registered an increase of 43.00% over the previous month and an increase of 3.52% over February 1951, while estimated production of all operators increased 32.08% over January 1952 but decreased 4.00% from February 1951. Shipments of reporting operators totalled 137,886 M ft. in February as compared with 99,898 M ft. in January, an increase of 38.02% and reported stocks on hand at the end of February amounted to 441,739 as compared with 382,939 M ft. on the last day of January, an increase of 15.35%.

Tables 2 to 5 give the production, shipments and stocks on hand of the mills reporting only. It is to be noted that all these

ET STOCKS EN MAINS DES SCIERIES
A L'EST DES ROCHEUSES

FEVRIER, 1952

Les rapports de 1,191 exploitants ont été colligés pour février dont les moulins ont contribué 63.31 p.c. de la production à l'est des Rocheuses en 1949. Grâce à ces rapports, on a pu faire des estimations préliminaires pour toutes les scieries de ces provinces.

D'après ces calculs, la production de bois d'oeuvre à l'est des Rocheuses (traverses sciées exclues) aurait atteint 232,874 M p.m.p. en février comparativement à 176,313 M p.m.p. le mois précédent et à 242,582 M p.m.p. en février 1951.

Le tableau 1 donne un résumé comparé de la production des exploitants qui font rapport, de la production estimative de tous les exploitants, et des expéditions et des stocks des exploitants qui font rapport. Ce tableau fait voir que la production déclarée en février augmente de 43.00 p. 100 comparativement au mois précédent et augmente de 3.52 p. 100 comparativement à février 1951. Par ailleurs, la production estimative de tous les exploitants augmente de 32.08 p. 100 comparativement à janvier 1952 mais diminue de 4.00 p. 100 comparativement à février de 1951. Les expéditions des exploitants qui font rapport s'établissent, au total, à 137,886 M p. au regard de 99,898 M p. en janvier, augmentation de 38.02 p. 100. Les stocks en mains déclarés à la fin de février sont de 441,739 M p. comparativement à 382,939 M p. le dernier jour de janvier, augmentation de 15.35 p. 100.

Les tableaux 2 à 5 donnent la production, les expéditions et les stocks des seules scieries qui font rapport. Il faut remarquer que tous ces chiffres

figures may cover different mills from month to month and also that quantities for shipments and stocks on hand sometimes include lumber purchased for resale by certain mills.

The 412 mills which reported sawing in February produced 135,475 M ft. of softwoods and 13,815 M ft. of hardwoods. This compared with 361 mills reporting the production of 94,153 M ft. of softwoods and 10,246 M ft. of hardwoods in January. Details by provinces and species are given in Table 2.

Shipments during February were reported by 489 operators, as compared with 439 in January. Particulars of shipments are given in Table 3. It is to be noted, however, that the first destination only is given and that some of the lumber shipped to wholesalers and exporters will eventually be reshipped to other provinces or exported. Similarly, much of the lumber shipped to wholesalers and retailers will eventually be used by building contractors, manufacturers and others.

Table 4 gives details of sawmill lumber stocks by provinces and by species, separating lumber sold but not shipped and lumber unsold. Stocks by species are further separated by grades, and unsold stocks are classified by thicknesses. Stocks at the end of February reported by 303 mills amounted to 441,739 M ft. of which 277,494 M ft. were sold and 164,245 M ft. unsold.

Table 5 shows the number of operators reporting, by provinces, and also the percentage of the sample to the 1949 production of all mills in the provinces covered.

NOTE: Tables 1 to 5 of this survey deal with production in all provinces east of the Rockies (except Newfoundland), shipments from sawmills in those provinces to the various domestic and foreign markets and to the various classes of customers, and stocks of sawn lumber on hand in sawmill yards at the end of the month. This survey is restricted to mills having an annual output of 500,000 or more feet board measure except in Prince Edward Island where it also includes mills in the 200 to 499 M ft. class. Sawmills in the 500,000 feet and over class accounted for 82.01 per cent of the total production of sawn lumber in 1949, in the eight provinces covered.

Les 412 moulins qui ont rapporté du sciage en février ont produit 135,475 M p. de bois tendre et 13,815 M p. de bois dur. Pour janvier, 361 scieries ont rapporté la production de 94,153 M p. de bois tendre et 10,246 M p. de bois dur. Les détails par province et par essence paraissent au tableau 2.

Les expéditions en février ont été déclarées par 489 exploitants, comparativement à 439 pour janvier, et paraissent en détail au tableau 3. A noter, cependant, que la première destination seulement est indiquée et qu'une partie du bois expédié aux grossistes et exportateurs sera éventuellement réexpédiée à d'autres provinces ou exportée. De même une grande partie du bois expédié aux grossistes et aux détaillants sera ultimement utilisée par les entrepreneurs en construction, les manufacturiers et d'autres.

Les stocks de bois aux mains des scieries, par province et par essence, paraissent en détail au tableau 4, distinction étant faite entre le bois vendu mais non expédié et le bois non vendu. Les stocks par essence sont de plus séparés selon la qualité et les stocks non vendus sont classifiés selon l'épaisseur. Les stocks déclarés à la fin de février par 303 moulins s'élevaient à 441,739 M p. dont 277,494 M p. vendus et 164,245 M p. non vendus.

Le tableau 5 donne le nombre d'exploitants faisant rapport, par province, et aussi le pourcentage de l'échantillon en fonction de la production de toutes les scieries dans les provinces concernées pour 1949.

NOTA: Les tableaux 1 à 5 de ce relevé portent sur la production de bois scié dans toutes les provinces à l'est des Rocheuses, (sauf Terre-Neuve), sur les expéditions des scieries de ces provinces aux divers marchés domestiques et étrangers et aux diverses catégories de clients, et sur les stocks de bois scié, en mains dans les cours des scieries à la fin du mois. Ce relevé est limité aux scieries dont la production annuelle est de 500,000 pieds ou plus, mesure de planche, sauf dans le cas de l'Île du Prince-Edouard où il comprend aussi les scieries produisant de 200 à 499 M p. Les scieries dont la production atteignait ou dépassait 500,000 pieds ont contribué en 1949, 82.01 pour cent de la production totale de bois scié dans les huit provinces en question.
