# PRODUCTION, SHIPMENTS AND STOCKS ON HAND OF SAWMILLS IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

### September, 1960

Production of sawn lumber and ties in British Columbia totalled 457,492 M ft. in September, 1960 as compared with 350,487 M ft. in September, 1959 an increase of 30.5 p.c. over the previous year but a decrease of 8.2 p.c. from the previous month. Production of Coast mills, which accounts for 52 p.c. of the total, showed an increase of 76.1 p.c. over the same month of the previous year, and the Interior mills, which produced the remaining 48 p.c. showed an increase of 1.9 p.c. Shipments in September, 1960 totalled 439,681 M ft., as compared with 321,889 M ft. the previous year, an increase of 36.6 p.c. with Coast mills registering an increase of 127.8 p.c. and Interior mills a decrease of 8.6 p.c. Total shipments for September decreased by 7.9 p.c. from the August figure of 477,421 M ft. Stocks on hand at the end of September, 1960 amounted to 740,301 M ft., as compared with 532,264 M ft. at the end of September the previous year and 737,182 M ft. at the end of August of this year. Coast mills reported stocks totalling 369,165 M ft., while Interior mills showed 371,136 M ft.

Summary Figures

Table 1 gives a comparative summary of production, shipments and stocks of sawn lumber and ties for all British Columbia sawmills for August and September 1959 and 1960. Details by species are given for production and stocks while shipments are shown by destination. Total production increased from 261,987 M ft. in August, 1959 to 350,487 M ft. in September, 1959 but decreased from 498,508 M ft. in August to 457,492 M ft. in September, 1960. Shipments totalled 477,421 M ft. in August, 1960 and 439,681 M ft. in September, 1960 as compared with 250,761 M ft. in August, 1959 and 321,889 M ft. in September of 1959. Stocks on hand at sawmills increased from 508,153 M ft. in August, 1959 to 532,264 M ft. in September 1959 and increased from 737,182 M ft. in August, 1960 to 740,301 M ft. in September of this year.

#### Production

Table 2 gives particulars of lumber and tie production for Coast mills and Interior mills separately, and also shows separately the production of lumber and ties, by species. Production of sawn lumber in Coast mills amounted to 237,108 M ft. in September, 1960 as compared with 216,062 M ft. reported by Interior mills. Sawn tie production of Coast mills was 927 M ft. in September as compared with 3,395 M ft. for Interior mills. Coast mills accounted for 52 p.c. of the total production of sawn lumber and ties in September, 1960 as compared with 38.6 p.c. the previous year. The percentages of Coast mills during August, 1960 and 1959 respectively, were 49.0 and 7.5 p.c.

Shipments

Table 3 gives details of lumber and tie shipments, by months, for Coast mills and Interior mills separately. Shipments by truck, by rail and waterborne are shown for each Canadian province, to points in the United States, to the United Kingdom and to other countries, for all mills reporting. Total estimated shipments of non-reporting mills are also given. It is to be noted, however, that some lumber originally reported as having been shipped to points in British Columbia may have been re-shipped to other provinces or exported by the purchasers and reported by them also, thereby causing a certain amount of duplication.

Shipments of Coast mills amounted to 242,922 M ft. in September of 1960 and 232,983 M ft. in August, 1960 as compared with 106,624 M ft. in September, 1959 and 17,699 M ft. in the previous month, while the Interior mills shipped 196,759 M ft. and 215,265 M ft. in September, 1960 and 1959 and 244,438 M ft. and 233,062 M ft. in August, 1960 and 1959. Of all shipments actually reported for September, 1960, 32.9 p.c. went to points in Canada, 44.5 p.c. to points in United States, 15.2 p.c. to the United Kingdom and 7.4 p.c. to other countries. Waterborne shipments accounted for 38 p.c. of the total, while 39.6 p.c. went by rail, 22.4 p.c. by truck.

Stocks

Table 4 gives particulars of stocks of lumber and ties at sawmills by months. It distinguishes between stocks sold but not shipped and stocks unsold, and between stocks at Coast and Interior mills, by species. Total stocks at Coast mills in August and September, 1960 amounted to 362,016 M ft. and 369,165 M ft. as compared with 263,954 M ft. and 272,859 M ft. in August and September of 1959. Interior mills stocks increased from 244,199 M ft. in August to 259,405 M ft. in September, 1959 and decreased from 375,166 M ft. in August to 371,136 M ft. in September, 1960. Unsold stocks accounted for approximately 42 p.c. of the total in September, 1960 as compared with 35.1 p.c. in September, 1959 for Coast mills, while for the Interior mills the percentages were, respectively, 91 and 92.2.

Orders on Hand

Table 5 shows the distribution of orders on hand at the end of the months of August and September, 1959 and 1960 for Coast mills only. Similar information is not collected from Interior mills and no attempt has been made to estimate orders on hand of non-reporting mills on the Coast. Destination and mode of shipments are shown in this table, which also gives total lumber purchases reported by some mills. Total orders on hand at the end of September, 1960 amounted to 297,414 M ft. as compared with 320,828 M ft. in September, 1959. Orders on hand at the end of August, 1960 and 1959 amounted to 336,171 M ft. and 296,675 M ft., respectively. Purchases of lumber from other mills amounted to 1,074 M ft. in September, 1960 and 5,165 M ft. in September, 1959 as compared with 2,205 M ft. in August, 1960 and 722 M ft. in August, 1959.

Active Mills Reporting

Table 6 gives the number of active mills reporting each month for the Coast and Interior of British Columbia. The mills reporting for September accounted for 77.7 p.c. of the total production on the basis of the annual returns from 1958 compared with 80.6 p.c. for the previous year. The percentages for August, 1959 and 1960 were 78.6 and 79.2 respectively. It is hoped that the compilation will eventually include all mills in the 500,000 feet and over classification.

The co-operation of the British Columbia Lumber Manufacturers' Association, Interior Lumber Manufacturers' Association and Northern Interior Lumbermen's Association in the collection of these statistics is gratefully acknowledged.
