

Production of sawn lumber and ties in British Columbia totalled 578,172 M bd. ft. in September 1964 as compared with 554,563 M bd. ft. in September 1963. Shipments increased in September 1964 to 545,652 M bd. ft. over 531,330 in September 1963. Stocks on hand showed an increase from 735,609 M bd. ft. in September 1963 to 819,550 M bd. ft. in September 1964.

Table 1 gives a comparative summary of production, shipments and stocks of sawn lumber and ties for all British Columbia sawmills, while Table 2 give particulars of lumber and tie production for Coast mills and Interior mills separately. Details of lumber and tie shipments by method of transport are given in Table 3, while Table 4 shows particulars of stocks of lumber and ties at sawmills. It should be noted that some lumber originally reported as having been shipped to points within British Columbia by some operators may also be reported as having been shipped by other operators, who, in addition to sawing lumber, also purchase or have lumber sawn by contract for them. This, of course, would result in some duplication.

Table 5 shows the distribution of orders on hand for Coast mills only, and also includes lumber purchases and some details of destination and method of transport.

Table 6 gives the number of mills reporting for the Coast and the Interior of British Columbia. The mills reporting for September accounted for 85.4 p.c. of the total production on the basis of the annual returns from 1962 compared with 81.4 p.c. for September of the previous year. It is to be hoped that the compilation will eventually include all mills in the 500,000 feet and over classification.
