

THE FURNITURE INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1938.

Ottawa, February, 1940. - The furniture industry includes all establishments engaged wholly or principally in the manufacture of wooden furniture of all kinds. It covers the greater part of the production of this commodity in Canada. There are, however, a number of firms classified in other industrial groups which make furniture as a side line to their principal production. The firms dealt with in the present report also manufacture commodities other than furniture as secondary products.

The furniture industry in Canada is centred in southwestern Ontario. Out of a total of 392 establishments in 1938, 198 were located in this province. The distribution for the remaining provinces was as follows: Quebec 90, British Columbia 58, Manitoba 28, Alberta 12, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Saskatchewan 2 each.

Capital employed in these concerns in 1938 was reported at \$26,585,729, a decrease of 3.1 p.c. from the previous year. The value placed on lands, buildings, fixtures, machinery and tools was \$14,274,830; materials, stocks in process and finished products on hand were valued at \$6,935,542; and cash, trading and operating accounts totalled \$5,375,357.

The average number of employees in 1938 was 10,284 as compared with 10,804 in 1937. The number of salaried employees was 1,539 and the payments for salaries during the year totalled \$2,325,365. The monthly average number of wage-earners was 8,745 while the wage pay-roll amounted to \$7,062,862.

Expenditures for fuel during the year totalled \$284,356 as against \$274,005 in 1937. Bituminous coal cost \$194,510; anthracite \$8,773; coke \$1,323; gasoline \$807; kerosene \$157; fuel oil \$3,310; wood \$19,245; mill waste \$28,841; sawdust and shavings \$25,030; gas \$1,837; and other fuel \$525. The total value of electricity purchased in 1938 amounted to \$210,701.

L'INDUSTRIE DU MEUBLE AU CANADA, 1938.

Ottawa, février 1940. - L'industrie du meuble comprend tous les établissements dont l'occupation exclusive ou principale consiste dans la fabrication de meubles de toutes sortes en bois. Elle tient compte de la plus grande partie de la production de tels articles au Canada. Il y a, toutefois, un certain nombre d'établissements, classés dans d'autres groupes industriels, qui fabriquent des meubles en à côté, de même que les établissements dont traite ce rapport fabriquent, comme produits secondaires, d'autres articles que les meubles en bois.

L'industrie du meuble au Canada a son centre dans le sud-ouest de l'Ontario. Sur 392 établissements en 1938, 198 étaient situés dans cette province. La part qui revient aux autres provinces se répartit comme suit: Québec 90, Colombie Britannique 58, Manitoba 28, Alberta 12, Nouvelle-Ecosse 2, Nouveau-Brunswick 2 et Saskatchewan 2.

On estime à \$26,585,729 les capitaux engagés dans ce genre d'industrie en 1938, soit 3.1 p.c. de moins que l'année précédente. La valeur attribuée aux terrains, bâtiments, machinerie, outillage, etc. est de \$14,274,830; les matières premières, les marchandises en voie de fabrication et les produits finis en mains s'élèvent à \$6,935,542 à la fin de l'année; et l'argent en caisse et les comptes courants se totalisent à \$5,375,357.

En moyenne, le nombre d'employés en 1938 a été de 10,284 comparativement à 10,804 en 1937. Le nombre d'employés à salaire s'élevait à 1,539 qui reçurent durant l'année la somme de \$2,325,365. La moyenne mensuelle d'employés à gages s'élevait à 8,745 et la liste de paye les concernant à \$7,062,862.

Le coût du combustible durant l'année représente un total de \$284,356, contre \$274,- 005 en 1937, se répartissant comme suit: \$194,- 510 en charbon bitumineux; \$8,773 en anthracite; \$1,323 en coke; \$807 en gazoline; \$157 en kérosène; \$3,310 en huile combustible; \$19,245 en bois; \$28,841 en déchets de bois; \$25,030 en sciure et copeaux, \$1,837 en gaz et \$525 en d'autres combustibles. La valeur de l'électricité achetée en 1938 représentait \$210,701.

Power employed in the industry totalled 20,762 h.p. from 2,292 units of the following classes: 47 steam engines rated at 6,323 h.p.; 4 diesel engines rated at 411 h.p.; 6 gazoline engines rated at 129 h.p.; 7 hydraulic turbines rated at 659 h.p. and 2,228 electric motors run by purchased power with a total rating of 13,240 h.p. There were also 238 electric motors rated at 2,190 h.p. which were run by power generated by the primary units and 116 boilers rated at 12,413 h.p.

Materials used in manufacturing in 1938 cost \$10,100,463 as against a corresponding figure of \$10,965,149 in the previous year. Sawn lumber is the most important material used in the manufacture of furniture. The hardwood used is to a large extent imported from the United States and tropical sources, while the softwoods are chiefly the product of Canadian saw-mills. Hardwood lumber amounted to 56,115 M ft.b.m. valued at \$2,187,017; softwood lumber to 19,448 M ft.b.m. valued at \$501,534; softwood and hardwood bolts to 2,823 cords valued at \$22,348; veneer 17,614 M surf. ft. valued at \$506,560; plywood 12,491 M surf. ft. valued at \$422,863; blocks, blanks, squares and other wood valued at \$20,474 and furniture frames valued at \$439,091. Textile coverings, fibre, hardware, paint, oils, varnish, leather, etc. were among the more important of the remaining items which were valued at \$6,000,576.

The furniture manufactured by this industry consists chiefly of household furniture which in 1938 was valued at \$16,018,941 and was made up of upholstered living-room furniture valued at \$5,966,112, bedroom furniture valued at \$4,-667,832, dining room furniture valued at \$2,190,-179, kitchen furniture valued at \$1,619,661 and miscellaneous household furniture valued at \$1,575,157. The next most important items were those of office and store furniture and fixtures at \$1,675,219; furniture and fixtures for churches, schools and other public buildings \$1,266,733; radio cabinets \$842,274; furniture frames \$721,633; cedar and other chests \$387,737; miscellaneous cabinet work \$537,948; picture and mirror frames \$300,288; mattresses \$227,891; children's furniture \$190,833; camp, lawn and verandah furniture \$153,909; wicker, reed, rattan and willow furniture \$106,667; clock cases \$66,244; and bed springs \$56,877. Other less important classes were pillows, sashes and doors. A total of \$453,833 was received for repair work and other miscellaneous products of all classes amounted to \$994,481.

La force motrice employée dans cette industrie se totalise par 20,762 h.p. provenant de 2,292 unités des classes suivantes: 47 machines à vapeur à 6,323 h.p.; 4 moteurs Diesel à 411 h.p.; 6 moteurs à gazoline à 129 h.p.; 7 turbines hydrauliques à 659 h.p.; et 2,228 moteurs électriques activés par de l'électricité achetée ayant une puissance globale de 13,240 h.p. On comptait aussi 238 moteurs électriques développant 2,190 h.p. activés par l'électricité produite par les unités primaires et 116 chaudières de 12,413 h.p.

Les matières premières entrant dans la fabrication ont coûté \$10,100,463 en 1938, comparativement à \$10,965,149 l'année précédente. Le bois de sciage est la matière la plus importante entrant dans la fabrication des meubles. Le bois dur est en grande partie importé des Etats-Unis et des pays tropicaux tandis que le bois tendre est principalement le produit des scieries canadiennes. Le bois dur représentait 56,115 M p.m.p. valant \$2,187,-017 et le bois tendre 19,448 M p.m.p. valant \$501,534; on dépensa aussi \$22,348 pour 2,823 cordes de billotins de bois dur et tendre; \$506,560 pour 17,614 M p.sup. de bois déroulé; \$422,864 pour 12,491 M p.sup. de bois contreplaqué; \$20,474 pour blocs, blancs, carrés et autres bois; et \$439,091 pour des châssis de meubles à finir ou rembourrer. Les étoffes à couvrir, la fibre, la quincaillerie, la peinture, les huiles, le vernis, le cuir, etc., sont au nombre des autres matières importantes entrant dans la fabrication des meubles et valaient \$6,000,576.

Les produits de cette industrie consistent principalement en meubles de ménage, lesquels sont évalués à \$16,018,941 en 1938, comprenant sous ce titre \$5,966,112 de meubles rembourrés de salon, \$4,667,832 de meubles de chambre à coucher, \$2,190,179 de meubles de salle à dîner, \$1,619,661 de meubles de cuisine et \$1,575,157 d'autres meubles de maison. Les autres item qui suivent en importance sont les meubles et agencements de bureaux et magasins évalués à \$1,675,219; meubles et équipement d'églises, d'écoles et d'autres édifices publics \$1,266,-733; ébénisterie de radiophone \$842,274; châssis de meubles \$721,633; travaux divers d'ébénisterie \$337,948; cadres de tableaux et miroirs \$300,288; matelas \$227,891; meubles pour enfants \$190,833; meubles pour camps, parterres et vérandas \$153,-909; meubles en osier, roseau, rotin, etc. \$106,667; ébénisterie d'horloge \$66,244; et sommiers \$56,877. D'autres classes de moindre importance sont les oreillers et les portes et châssis. Un total de \$453,833 a été reçu pour l'ouvrage de réparation et les autres produits ont donné la somme de \$994,481.

The market for Canadian furniture is chiefly domestic as shown by the fact that only \$174,098 worth of Canadian-made furniture was exported during the calendar year 1938, while the total annual production of furniture and other products in the industry as a whole was close to twenty-four million dollars. The imports of furniture amounted to \$957,442 during the same period.

The following tables give, first, a summary of the principal statistics of the industry in 1937 and 1938, followed by comparative detailed tables for both years covering the distribution of establishments, capital invested, employment, fuel, power equipment, materials used, products manufactured and exports and imports.

Le marché du meuble canadien est surtout domestique comme le prouve suffisamment le fait qu'une valeur de seulement \$174,098 a été exportée durant l'année civile 1938, alors que la production de meubles et d'autres produits dans l'industrie toute entière s'est élevée à près de vingt-quatre millions de dollars. Les importations s'élevaient à \$957,442 durant la même période.

Les tableaux qui suivent donnent, premièrement, un résumé des principales statistiques de l'industrie en 1937 et 1938, suivi par des tableaux détaillés pour ces deux années couvrant la distribution des établissements, les capitaux engagés, l'emploiement, le combustible, la force motrice, les matières employées, les produits manufacturés et les exportations et importations.
