

THE FURNITURE INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1939.

Ottawa, February, 1941. - The furniture industry includes establishments engaged wholly or principally in the manufacture of wooden furniture of all kinds. It covers the greater part of the production of this commodity in Canada. There are, however, a number of firms classified in other industrial groups which make furniture as a side line to their principal production. The firms dealt with in the present report also manufacture commodities other than furniture as secondary products.

The furniture industry in Canada is centred in southwestern Ontario. Out of a total of 378 establishments in 1939, 139 were located in this province. The distribution for the remaining provinces was as follows: Quebec 85, British Columbia 54, Manitoba 31, Alberta 11, New Brunswick and Saskatchewan 3 each, and Nova Scotia 2.

Capital employed in these concerns in 1939 was reported at \$27,923,372, an increase of 5 p.c. over the previous year. The value placed on lands, buildings, fixtures, machinery and tools was \$14,503,289; materials, stocks in process and finished products on hand were valued at \$7,209,584; and cash, trading and operating accounts totalled \$6,210,499.

The average number of employees in 1939 was 10,576 as compared with 10,284 in 1938. The number of salaried employees was 1,585 and the payments for salaries during the year totalled \$2,496,526. The monthly average number of wage-earners was 8,991 while the wage pay-roll amounted to \$7,462,744.

Expenditures for fuel during the year totalled \$288,276 as against \$284,356 in 1938. Bituminous coal cost \$193,434; anthracite \$6,893; coke \$1,359; gasoline \$398; kerosene \$11; fuel oil \$3,427; wood \$16,503; mill waste \$36,547; sawdust and shavings \$27,248; gas \$1,877; and other fuel \$79. The total value of electricity purchased in 1939 amounted to \$216,324.

L'INDUSTRIE DU MEUBLE AU CANADA, 1939.

Ottawa, février 1941. - L'industrie du meuble comprend les établissements dont l'occupation exclusive ou principale consiste dans la fabrication de meubles de toutes sortes en bois. Elle tient compte de la plus grande partie de la production de tels articles au Canada. Il y a, toutefois, un certain nombre d'établissements, classés dans d'autres groupes industriels, qui fabriquent des meubles en à côté, de même que les établissements dont traite ce rapport fabriquent, comme produits secondaires, d'autres articles que les meubles en bois.

L'industrie du meuble au Canada a son centre dans le sud-ouest de l'Ontario. Sur 378 établissements en 1939, 139 étaient situés dans cette province. La part qui revient aux autres provinces se répartit comme suit: Québec 85, Colombie Britannique 54, Manitoba 31, Alberta 11, Nouveau-Brunswick 3, Saskatchewan 3, et Nouvelle-Écosse 2.

On estime à \$27,923,372 les capitaux engagés dans ce genre d'industrie en 1939, soit 5 p.c. de plus que l'année précédente. La valeur attribuée aux terrains, bâtiments, machinerie, outillage, etc. est de \$14,503,289; les matières premières, les marchandises en voie de fabrication et les produits finis en mains s'élèvent à \$7,209,584 à la fin de l'année; et l'argent en caisse et les comptes courants se totalisent à \$6,210,499.

En moyenne, le nombre d'employés en 1939 a été de 10,576 comparativement à 10,284 en 1938. Le nombre d'employés à salaire s'est élevé à 1,585 qui reçoivent durant l'année la somme de \$2,496,526. La moyenne mensuelle d'employés à gages s'est élevée à 8,991 et la liste de paie les concernant à \$7,462,744.

Le coût du combustible durant l'année représente un total de \$288,276, contre \$284,-356 en 1938, se répartissant comme suit: \$193,-434 en charbon bitumineux; \$6,893 en anthracite; \$1,359 en coke; \$398 en gazoline; \$11 en kerosène; \$3,427 en huile combustible; \$16,503 en bois; \$36,547 en déchets de bois; \$27,248 en sciure et copeaux, \$1,877 en gaz et \$79 en d'autres combustibles. La valeur de l'électricité achetée en 1939 représentait \$216,324.

Power employed in the industry totalled 21,171 h.p. from 2,403 units of the following classes: 50 steam engines rated at 6,525 h.p.; 5 diesel engines rated at 283 h.p.; 3 gasoline engines rated at 41 h.p.; 9 hydraulic turbines rated at 911 h.p. and 2,336 electric motors run by purchased power with a total rating of 13,406 h.p. There were also 367 electric motors rated at 2,635 h.p. while were run by power generated by the primary units and 115 boilers rated at 12,403 h.p.

Materials used in manufacturing in 1939 cost \$10,934,029 as against a corresponding figure of \$10,100,463 in the previous year. Sawn lumber is the most important material used in the manufacture of furniture. The hardwood used is to a large extent imported from the United States and tropical sources, while the softwoods are chiefly the product of Canadian saw-mills. Hardwood lumber amounted to 62,557 M ft.b.m. valued at \$2,341,855; softwood lumber to 16,944 M ft.b.m. valued at \$457,009; softwood and hardwood bolts to 332 cords valued at \$2,576; veneer 29,948 M surf. ft. valued at \$589,099; plywood 11,790 M surf. ft. valued at \$411,291; blocks, blanks, squares and other wood valued at \$15,408 and furniture frames valued at \$434,193. Textile coverings, fibre, hardware, paint, oils, varnish, leather, etc. were among the more important of the remaining items which were valued at \$6,682,593.

The furniture manufactured by this industry consists chiefly of household furniture which in 1939 was valued at \$17,430,654 and was made up of upholstered living-room furniture valued at \$6,082,003, bedroom furniture valued at \$5,-300,425, dining room furniture valued at \$2,147,-003, kitchen furniture valued at \$1,735,253 and miscellaneous household furniture valued at \$2,165,970. The next most important items were those of office and store furniture and fixtures at \$1,873,640; furniture and fixtures for churches, schools and other public buildings \$1,241,998; furniture frames \$842,669; radio cabinets \$691,866; cedar and other chests \$411,-277; miscellaneous cabinet work \$359,408; camp, lawn and verandah furniture \$302,515; pictures and mirror frames \$292,140; mattresses \$231,518; children's furniture \$173,368; wicker, reed, rattan and willow furniture \$60,828, bed springs \$59,598; and sashes and doors \$44,152. A total of \$453,428 was received for repair work and other miscellaneous products of all classes amounted to \$1,160,211.

La force motrice employée dans cette industrie se totalise par 21,171 h.p. provenant de 2,403 unités des classes suivantes: 50 machines à vapeur à 6,525 h.p.; 5 moteurs Diesel à 283 h.p.; 3 moteurs à gazoline à 41 h.p.; 9 turbines hydrauliques à 911 h.p.; et 2,336 moteurs électriques activés par de l'électricité achetée ayant une puissance globale de 13,406 h.p. On comptait aussi 367 moteurs électriques développant 2,635 h.p. activés par l'électricité produite par les unités primaires et 115 chaudières de 12,403 h.p.

Les matières premières entrant dans la fabrication ont coûté \$10,934,029 en 1939, comparativement à \$10,100,463 l'année précédente. Le bois de sciage est la matière la plus importante entrant dans la fabrication des meubles. Le bois dur est en grande partie importé des Etats-Unis et des pays tropicaux tandis que le bois tendre est principalement le produit des scieries canadiennes. Le bois dur représentait 62,557 M p.m.p. valant \$2,341,-855 et le bois tendre 16,944 M p.m.p. valant \$457,009; on dépensa aussi \$2,576 pour 332 cordes de billotins de bois dur et tendre; \$589,099 pour 29,948 M p.sup. de bois déroulé; \$411,291 pour 11,790 M p.sup. de bois contre-plaqué; \$15,408 pour blocs, blancs, carrés et autres bois; et \$434,193 pour des châssis de meubles à finir ou rembourrer. Les étoffes à couvrir, la fibre, la quincaillerie, la peinture, les huiles, le vernis, le cuir, etc., sont au nombre des autres matières importantes entrant dans la fabrication des meubles et valaient \$6,682,593.

Les produits de cette industrie consistent principalement en meubles de ménage, lesquels sont évalués à \$17,430,654 en 1939, comprenant sous ce titre \$6,082,003 de meubles rembourrés de salon, \$5,300,425 de meubles de chambre à coucher, \$2,147,003 de meubles de salle à dîner, \$1,735,253 de meubles de cuisine et \$2,165,970 d'autres meubles de maison. Les autres items qui suivent en importance sont les meubles et agencements de bureaux et magasins évalués à \$1,873,640; meubles et équipement d'églises, d'écoles et d'autres édifices publics \$1,241,-998; châssis de meubles \$842,669; ébénisterie de radiophone \$691,866; coffres en cèdre et autres coffres \$411,277; travaux divers d'ébénisterie \$359,408; meubles pour camps, parterres et vérandas \$302,515; cadres de tableaux et miroirs \$292,140; matelas \$231,518; meubles pour enfants \$173,368; meubles en osier, roseau, rotin, etc. \$60,828; sommiers \$59,598; et portes et châssis \$44,152. Un total de \$453,428 a été reçu pour l'ouvrage de réparation et les autres produits ont donné la somme de \$1,160,211.

The market for Canadian furniture is chiefly domestic as shown by the fact that only \$173,602 worth of Canadian-made furniture was exported during the calendar year 1939, while the total annual production of furniture and other products in the industry as a whole was close to twenty-six million dollars. The imports of furniture of wood amounted to \$727,474 during the same period.

The following tables give, first, a summary of the principal statistics of the industry in 1938 and 1939, followed by comparative detailed tables for both years covering the distribution of establishments, capital invested, employment, fuel, power equipment, materials used, products manufactured and exports and imports.

Le marché du meuble canadien est surtout domestique comme le prouve suffisamment le fait qu'une valeur de seulement \$173,602 a été exportée durant l'année civile 1939, alors que la production de meubles et d'autres produits dans l'industrie toute entière s'est élevée à près de vingt-six millions de dollars. Les importations de meubles en bois s'élevaient à \$727,474 durant la même période.

Les tableaux qui suivent donnent, premièrement, un résumé des principales statistiques de l'industrie en 1938 et 1939, suivi par des tableaux détaillés pour ces deux années couvrant la distribution des établissements, les capitaux engagés, l'emploiement, le combustible, la force motrice, les matières employées, les produits manufacturés et les exportations et importations.


