THE BEEKEEPERS' AND POULTRYMEN'S
SUPPLY INDUSTRY, 1945

Ottawa, July, 1947. - The Beekeepers' and Poultrymen's Supply industry includes establishments engaged wholly or chiefly in the manufacture of incubators, hives and other supplies for poultrymen and beekeepers.

Ottawa, juillet 1947. - L'industrie des fournitures pour l'apiculture et l'aviculture comprend les établissements dont l'occupation exclusive ou principale consiste dans la fabrication de couveuses, ruches et autres fournitures pour aviculteurs et apiculteurs.
