THE PAPER BOX AND BAG INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1933.

Ottawa, November, 1934. - A report on the paper box and bag industry in Canada for 1932 and 1933 has just been issued by the Forestry Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics. This report gives the production of firms engaged wholly or chiefly in the manufacture of paper boxes and bags and covers the greater part of the production of these commodities in Canada. There are, however, a number of other firms classified in other industrial groups which make paper boxes and bags as a side line to their principal production. The firms dealt with in the present report also manufacture commodities other than paper boxes and bags as secondary products.

There were 132 establishments engaged in this industry in 1933 as against 126 in 1932. The distribution by provinces was as follows: - Ontario 81, Quebec 31, Manitoba 7, British Columbia 7, New Brunswick 3, Nova Scotia 2 and Alberta 1. Quebec reported an increase of one plant and Ontario an increase of five.

Capital investment in these concerns increased from \$20,110,391 to \$20,111,982 in 1933. The value placed on lands, buildings, machinery, tools, etc., was given at \$13,475,265, finished products on hand \$906,251, materials on hand and stocks in process amounted to \$2,311,763, and cash, trading and operating accounts and bills receivable to \$3,418,703.

The average number of employees in the paper box and bag industry in 1932 was 4,914 or 260 more than the number reported in 1932, and the total sum paid in salaries and wages was \$4,558,177 as compared with \$4,412,048 in 1932. The 832 salaried employees were paid \$1,674,961 and the 4,082 wage-earners received \$2,883,216 during the year.

Cost of fuel totalled \$99,691 an increase of \$5,321 over \$94,370 reported in 1932. Bituminous coal was valued at \$71,629, anthracite cost \$11,747, gas \$5,827, fuel oil \$5,174, lignite coal \$2,037, coke \$1,349, gasoline \$51, wood \$740, Kerosene \$42 and other fuel \$1,095. Expenditure on electric power during the year amounted to \$100,681 which represented the cost of 5,714,178 k.w.h. Power installation included two steam engines, one gasoline engine and one hydraulic turbine and 1,924 electric motors operated by purchased power with a total rating of 6,200 horse-power.

Materials used in the paper box and bag industry amounted to \$9,563,160 against \$8,787,604 in 1932. Paper and paper board were used to the amount of \$8,210,408 and formed 85.8 per cent of the total value of materials employed. Paper of all kinds was valued at \$2,838,700 and included \$1,054,819 of corrugating paper and \$23,846 of wrapping paper; paper board totalled 6,180 tons valued at \$580,618; folding board 29,474 tons at \$1,611,255; non-folding board 20,623 tons at \$891,130; liner board 43,195 tons at \$2,007,230; chip board 7,022 tons at \$281,475. Glue and other adhesives cost \$128,460; ink \$225,718; silicate of soda \$170,585; printing plates \$158,773; shipping containers \$61,977; paraffin \$49,887; die rule \$11,625 and die board \$7,225.

Production in 1933 was valued at \$17,800,330 as compared with the corresponding figure of \$17,026,439 recorded in 1932. The products manufactured in the order of their importance with regard to the value were: corrugated boxes \$5,161,280;

folding boxes \$4,003,134; stiff boxes \$3,612,418; self-opening bags \$1,278,283; bags n.e.s. \$947,791; fibre board boxes \$508,697; envelopes \$427,602; drinking cups \$208,387; special bags of glassine, waxed paper, cellophane, etc. \$158,362; corrugated paper and wrappers \$84,776; mailing tubes \$75,109; millinery bags \$63,731; all other boxes or cartons \$44,702; ice cream pails \$20,737; oyster pails \$9,310 and all other products including waxed paper, milk bottle caps, soda straws, round paper boxes, round liquid containers, adding machine rolls, egg case fillers, printing, transfer stamps, shipping tags, labels, paper covers, auto panels, display mounting, wrappers, paper, all other, jig saw puzzles, games and novelties, other printed advertising, lithographing, toilet tissue, pads and tablets, and cellophane garment covers \$1,196,011.

The following tables give, first, a summary of the principal statistics of the industry in 1932 and 1933, followed by comparative detailed tables for both years covering the distribution of establishments, capital invested, employment, fuel, power, materials used and products manufactured.
