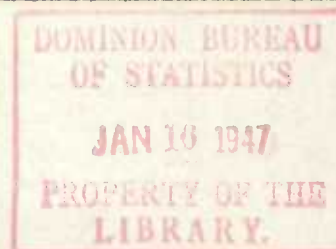

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

November, 1946



This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in November included the following items: brick 860,774 pieces; hollow blocks 1,078,544 pieces; cinder blocks 364,188 pieces; and pipe 8,527 tons.

Note: Figures given in this table cover the production of 50 firms which normally account for the following percentages of the total output in Canada of these items: concrete bricks and solid blocks 100 per cent; concrete hollow blocks 80 per cent; cinder blocks 100 per cent; cement pipe 92 per cent.
