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CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

JUNE, 1946

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the totals for Canada. Output in June included the following items: - brick, 348,735 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,319,763 pieces; cinder blocks, 561,717 pieces; and pipe, 7,048 tons.
