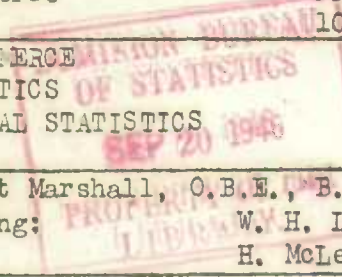

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT  
PIPE

July, 1946.

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the totals for Canada. Output in July included the following items: - brick, 1,069,385 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,328,859 pieces; solid blocks, 200 pieces; cinder blocks, 627,706 pieces; and pipe, 8,762 tons.
