CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

AUGUST, 1946

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in August included the following items: brick 624,667 pieces; hollow blocks 1,215,644 pieces; solid blocks 280 pieces; cinder blocks 541,299 pieces; and pipe 8,682 tons.
