## CONCRETE BUILDING ELOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

## JANUARY, 1947.

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in January included the following items: brick, 410,852 pieces; hollow blocks, 779,775 pieces; cinder blocks, 403,182 pieces; and pipe, 6,919 tons.
