CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

OCTOBER, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in October included the following items: brick, 1,844,163 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,628,923 pieces; cinder blocks, 646,506 pieces; solid blocks, 3,687 pieces; and pipe, 12,068 tons.
