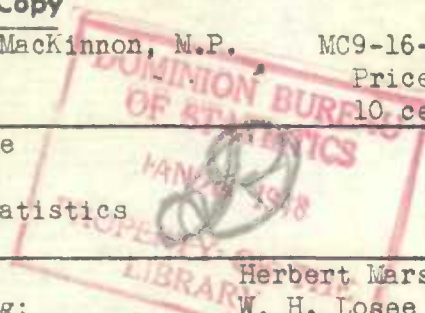

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPENOVEMBER, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 85 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in November included the following items: brick 1,225,149 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,320,852 pieces; cinder blocks, 601,521 pieces; solid blocks, 973 pieces; and pipe, 9,506 tons.

Note: Figures given in this table cover the production of 85 firms which normally account for the following percentages of the total output in Canada of these items: concrete bricks and solid bricks, 100 per cent; concrete hollow blocks, 80 per cent; cinder blocks, 100 per cent; cement pipe, 92 per cent.
