## DECEMBER, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in December included the following items: brick, 757,157 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,940,032 pieces; cinder blocks, 646,913 pieces; solid blocks, 15,300 pieces; and pipe, 11,597 tons.
