CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

FEBRUARY, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in February included the following items: brick 1,130,023 pieces; hollow blocks 695,713 pieces; cinder blocks 415,062 pieces; and pipe 7,293 tons.
