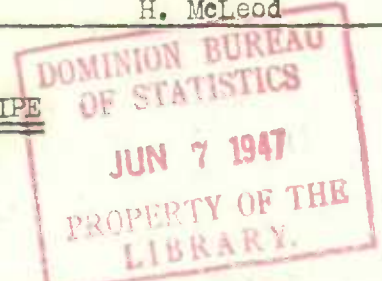

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

APRIL, 1947



This report on concrete building materials covers production by 50 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in April included the following items: brick 793,969 pieces; hollow blocks, 878,197 pieces; cinder blocks, 442,317 pieces; solid blocks, 750 pieces; and pipe 8,027 tons.

Note: Figures given in this table cover the production of 50 firms which normally account for the following percentages of the total output in Canada of these items: concrete bricks and solid bricks, 100 per cent; concrete hollow blocks, 80 per cent; cinder blocks, 100 per cent; cement pipe, 92 per cent.
