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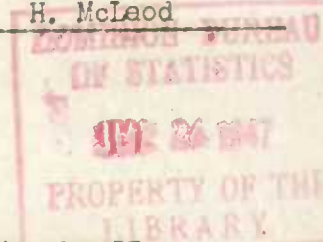

H. McLeodCONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPEMAY, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 57 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in May included the following items: brick, 1,118,068 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,470,414 pieces; cinder blocks, 467,631 pieces; and pipe, 10,433 tons.
