

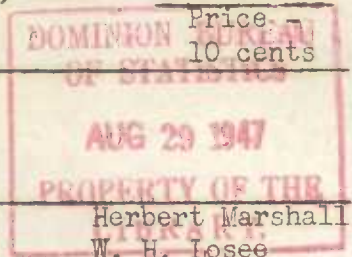
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CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

JUNE, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 58 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in June included the following items: brick, 1,690,350 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,922,340 pieces; cinder blocks, 690,809 pieces; solid blocks, 8,931 pieces; and pipe, 11,376 tons.

Note: Figures given in this table cover the production of 58 firms which normally account for the following percentages of the total output in Canada of these items: concrete bricks and solid bricks, 100 per cent; concrete hollow blocks, 80 per cent; cinder blocks, 100 per cent; cement pipe, 92 per cent.

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STATISTICAL INFORMATION

1967

The present report is a summary of the results of the 1967 survey of the
 statistical information which was compiled by the 25 per cent of the total
 population. It is based on the data collected in the 1967 survey of the
 population of Canada. The data are presented in the following tables.

Information is given on the number of persons in Canada who were
 aged 15 and over in 1967.

Table 1 shows the total number of persons in Canada who were
 aged 15 and over in 1967. The total number of persons in Canada
 aged 15 and over in 1967 was 13,232,000. This represents an
 increase of 1.2 per cent over the total number of persons in Canada
 aged 15 and over in 1966.
