CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

September, 1947

This report on concrete building materials covers production by 85 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 35 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in September included the following items: brick, 1,471,242 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,518,841 pieces; cinder blocks, 591,036 pieces; solid blocks, 2,351 pieces; and pipe, 11,343 tons.
