CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

JANU/RY, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in January included the following items: brick, 606,360 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,415,736 pieces; cinder clocks, 678,930 pieces; and pipe, 9,690 tons.

Production in Canada and Factory Shipments of Specified Concrete Products, January, 1948

Note: Figures given in this table cover the production of 87 firms which normally account for the following percentages of the total output in Canada of these items: concrete blocks and solid blocks 100 per cent; concrete hollow blocks 80 per cent; cinder blocks 100 per cent; cement pipe 92 per cent.
