CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

JANUARY, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in January included the following items: brick, 606,360 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,415,736 pieces; cinder blocks, 678,930 pieces; and pipe, 9,690 tons.
