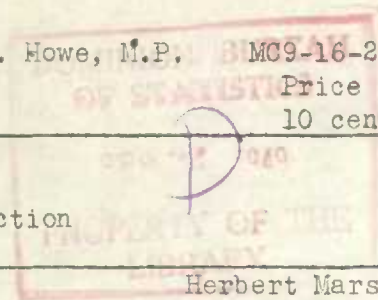

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPENOVEMBER - 1948.

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 108 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in November included the following items: Brick, 2,634,120 pieces; hollow blocks, 3,227,359 pieces; cinder blocks, 932,509 pieces; and pipe, 11,278 tons.
