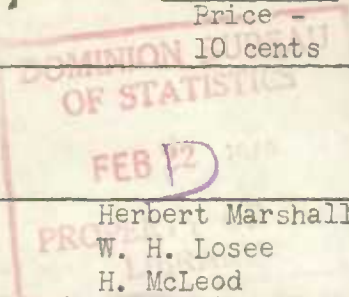

CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPEDECEMBER, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 102 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in December included the following items: brick, 1,702,209 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,540,702 pieces; cinder blocks, 756,821 pieces; and pipe, 8,376 tons.
