CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

FEBRUARY, 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in February included the following items: brick, 934,659 pieces; hollow blocks, 1,339,518 pieces; cinder blocks, 671,483 pieces; and pipe, 10,226 tons.
