CONCRETE BUILDING BLOCKS AND CEMENT PIPE

MARCH - 1948

This report on concrete building materials covers production of 87 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total for Canada. Output in March included the following items: brick, 1,373,722 pieces; hollow blocks, 1;718,837 pieces; cinder blocks, 631,199 pieces; and pipe, 32,901 tons.
